Local Law 14 -2009

A LOCAL LAW authorizing the Nassau County Office of Economic Development to apply for designation of a certain facility in Plainview, New York, as a Regionally Significant Project under the New York State Empire Zones Program

Passed by the Nassau County Legislature on July 7, 2009 Voting: ayes: 18, nayes: 0, abstained: 0
Became a law on July 9, 2009 with the approval of the County Executive.

WHEREAS, the New York State Empire Zones Program (the "Program") authorizes the certification of "Regionally Significant Projects" in Nassau County that are eligible for Empire Zone benefits even though outside the boundaries of the seven areas designated as the Nassau County Empire Zone; and

WHEREAS, Clever Devices, Ltd. ("Clever Devices") proposes to expand its transit technology manufacturing facilities at the property in Plainview, New York, designated as Section 13, Block 97, Lot 28; and the property in Plainview, New York, designated as Section 13, Block 98, Lot 29; and

WHEREAS, the location, expansion and increased employment at the aforedescribed Clever Devices facilities would be in the best interests of Nassau County and the local community; and

WHEREAS, the New York State Department of Economic Development has determined that the proposed expansion is eligible for Empire Zone benefits as a Regionally Significant Project under the Program; now therefore

BE IT ENACTED by the County Legislature of the County of Nassau as follows:

Section 1. Local Law 8-2005 is amended to add a new section 2h, to read as follows:

2h. The Nassau County Office of Economic Development, on behalf of the County of Nassau, is hereby authorized and empowered to submit an application for designation of the project proposed by Clever Devices, in regard to facilities at the property in Plainview, New York, designated as Section 13, Block 97, Lot 28, and at the property in Plainview, New York, designated as Section 13, Block 98, Lot 29, as a Regionally Significant Project pursuant to Article 18-B of the General Municipal Law.

§ 2. This local law shall take effect immediately.
