ALOCALLAW TO AMEND THE NASSAU COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE IN RELATION TO DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURES REGARDING POLICE BENEVOLENT ASSOCIATION MEMBERS

Passed by the Nassau County Legislature on May 21, 2012 Voting: ayes: 14 nayes: 5 abstained: 0

Became a law on June 18, 2012 with the approvel of the County Executive.

BE IT ENACTED by the County Legislature as follows:

Section 1. Section 8-13.0(e) of the Nassau County Administrative Code is hereby REPEALED.

§2. Severability. If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section, or part of this law or the application thereof to any person, individual, corporation, firm, partnership, entity, or circumstance shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section or part of this law, or in its application to the person, individual, corporation, firm, partnership, entity, or circumstance directly involved in the controversy in which such order or judgment shall be rendered.

- §3. It is hereby determined, pursuant to the provisions of the State Environmental Quality Review Act, 8 N.Y.E.C.L. section 0101 et seq. and its implementing regulations, Part 617 of 6 N.Y.C.R.R., and Section 1611 of the County Government Law of Nassau County, that the adoption of this ordinance is a "Type II" Action within the meaning of Section 617.5(c)(20) and (27) of 6 N.Y.C.R.R., and, accordingly, is of a class of actions which do not have a significant effection the environment, with no further review is required.
- §4. This Local Law shall take effect immediately.
