LOCAL LAW <sub>1</sub> -2022

A LOCAL LAW TO AMEND THE NASSAU COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE CODE TO EXTEND THE DEADLINE TO FILE AN APPLICATION FOR THE CORRECTION OF AN ASSESSMENT FOR THE TENTATIVE ASSESSMENT ROLL FILED ON JANUARY 3, 2022

Passed by the Nassau County Legislature on February 7, 2022 Voting: Ayes: 17, Nayes: 0, Abstained: 0 Became a law on February 10, 2022 with the approval of the Deputy County Executive acting on behalf of the County Executive

BE IT ENACTED by the County Legislature of Nassau County as follows:

Section 1. §6-40.3 **Application for the correction of assessment for taxation** of the Nassau County Administrative Code is amended to include the following section subdivision:

(f) Notwithstanding the foregoing, for any grievance for the correction of an assessment contained in the tentative assessment roll filed by the Department of Assessment on January 3, 2022, the deadline to file an application for the correction of an assessment shall be April 30, 2022.

## §2. Severability.

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section, or part of this law or the application thereof to any person or circumstance shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder hereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section, or part of this law, or in its application to the person or circumstance directly involved in the controversy in which such order or judgment shall be rendered.

§3. S.E.Q.R.A. It is hereby determined, pursuant to the provisions of the State Environmental Quality Review Act, 8 N.Y.E.C.L., section 0101 et seq. and its implementing regulations, Part

617 of 6 N.Y.C.R.R., and section 1611 of the County Government Law of Nassau County, that the adoption of this local law is a "Type II" Action within the meaning of Section 617.5(c)(20) and (27) of 6 N.Y.C.R.R., and, accordingly, is of a class of actions which do not have a significant effect on the environment; and no further review is required.

§4. Effective date. This local law shall take effect immediately.
