- 4. Progress for 40 Cruickshank & Progress for 147 Harvard: The Village of

Hempstead's Mayor agreed to forgive the liens on both properties. The Executive Director will be reaching our weekly to ensure that this topics are presented and accepted to the Village of Hempstead's Board. The engagement to the village is also to work on a number of items pertaining to the land the the Land Bank has in the Village.

- 5. Response to purchase 7 Dewey: Board has agreed to sell the properties and aske for a best and final offer on the Land. The Lane will have the deed restriction and convents to align with affordable housing. The Land Banks's legal Counsel provided the language to respond to the offers made for this property.
