Summary

The Application Developer Specialist level 5 is a highly skilled technical position with up-to-date, expert knowledge of Enterprise Resource Planning Applications, scripting and coding languages, computers, and communications systems, industry standards and trends, current and evolving vendor products and services across a broad range of technology categories including PeopleSoft. Utilizing this experience, the Application Developer Specialist level 5 will design business solutions, produce customizations, evaluate, advise, select third party bolt-ons and oversee the implementation of technologies integrated with the PeopleSoft system to best meet the consolidated needs of the MTA and its constituent agencies. This position will be assigned to work in the BSC Information Technology Services Division in one of three support areas 1) Human Resources/Payroll 2) Financials or 3) Benefits/Customs. The Application Developer Specialist level 5 will lead application support of the critical business functions (Payroll, Human Resources, Benefits, Procurement, Inventory, ELM, Budget and Financials) and the integration with various systems (Timekeeping, Capital, Maintenance Management, Operational and Administrative) throughout the MTA and the agencies. These touch points systems at the agencies range from home grown legacy systems, customized off the shelf (COTS) products and leading edge state of the art transportation and information systems.

Responsibilities

This is a performance based position. Performance objectives and indicators have been designed to measure the successful candidate's achievements on a quarterly basis. The employee must meet or exceed these detailed goals as a condition of employment. Other responsibilities include:

Share technological knowledge with BSC IT team to support enhancements, modifications and additions with regards to potential Bolt-ons to Peoplesoft; provide advice and recommendations for the integrations of new technologies.

Support IT Human Resources and Payroll functions as needed and make suggestions for business process improvements based on emerging technology

Coordinate and guide IT staff with regards to providing enhancements to self-service, portal and web enhancements.

Build and design integrations to /from PeopleSoft, Hyperion or other BSC systems with the touch point applications of the MTA and its agencies, both in house and in the cloud.

Assist in the completion of tasks to ensure and enhance the Units effectiveness in the completion of its

Utilize knowledge and experience with PeopleSoft (HCM, Financials or Benefits) and/or Oracle Hyperion products and the technologies to deploy new mobile architecture, web architecture or cloud architecture and improved features.

Review system development life cycle deliverables and other pertinent planning documents for the requirements definition, design, construction and technology acquisition for complex projects utilizing highly skilled technology disciplines.

Perform research on state of the art information technologies, presenting and making recommendations Analyze and report on the information technology impact to other agency functions and systems; ensures the interoperability of systems and initiatives.

Perform other duties within the IT Unit as assigned or as required.
