SUMMER RECREATION DETAILS

DATES: June 25th- August 9th, 2018

PROGRAM DAY: 8:30am-3pm or (Full day option 8:30am-5:30pm)

IMPORTANT NOTED: Severe Weather could cancel the Summer Recreation Program. The Summer Recreation Program is an outdoor program and will not commence if there is severe weather before camp begins and the program MAY be cancelled should there be severe weather throughout the day. A phone call will be made to parents by 7:30 am if camp will be cancelled. Parents must retrieve children immediately if camp is cancelled during camp hours.

Pick up is PROMPTLY at 3pm or 5:30 pm. Failure to pick up your child in a timely manner may result in expulsion from camp.

Parents are encouraged to provide children with sunscreen and instruct in self-use. All clothing and personal items that children will bring to camp must be properly labeled.

AGES: 5 - 12 separated in the following categories: early childhood (5-6); juniors (7 - 8); intermediate (9 - 10); and seniors (11 - 12). Grouping with friend requests will be honored to the best of the camps ability, but may be limited to number of friends and age categories of children.

ACTIVITIES: In addition to 45 minutes of open swim (three parks.) a typical day can include: arts & crafts; board games; Quick Start Tennis; 1st Tee Golf, and sports such as baseball, basketball, flag football, wiffle ball, Kan Jam, soccer, tennis, volley ball, and golf. Nassau County reserves the right to limit the activities at each park.





REGISTRATION DEADLINE MAY 21, 2018: Registration fee of \$50 applies to returning campers (from 2017) who register by March 16th, 2018. Registration fee of \$75 applies for new campers (regardless of registration date) and returning campers who apply after March 16, 2018. Registration fees are NOT refundable.

MID-ISLAND

Cantiague Park

Hicksville, West John Street | 516-571-7056 | East of Cantiague Rock Road

Centrally located in Hicksville, this 127-acre park offers a variety of recreational opportunities, with five tennis courts; three basketball courts; baseball and athletic fields, including a beautiful new multisport synthetic turf field; and a large playground. In addition, there is a summer "water theme" park with an Olympic-sized pool, two water slides, a diving pool, a "kiddie" pool, a training pool and an interactive water-play area. A mini-golf course, a nine-hole golf course, a driving range and the indoor ice-skating rink cap off the recreational facilities at Cantiague Park.

Eisenhower Park

A 930-acre oasis of open space and recreation in the heart of Nassau County, Eisenhower Park is one of the largest public spaces in the New York metropolitan area – larger, in fact, than Central Park. The park offers a full range of athletic and family activities, including dozens of athletic fields and courts; playgrounds; a fitness trail; a batting cage; mini-golf; 18-hole golf courses and a driving range. The Park's Harry Chapin Lakeside Theatre offers entertainment and varied programming throughout the summer months.

SOUTH SHORE

Nickerson Beach Park

Nickerson Beach is one of the County's true gems, boasting a magnificent beachfront that has undergone an extensive multimillion-dollar renovation in recent years. In 2009, Newsday praised the park as "Perfect for a family looking to let off a little steam," citing activities ranging from beach volleyball to basketball and tennis, as well as the state-of-the-art playground. The playground is part of a seamless area known as the "Fun Zone" that also provides a colorful basketball court and a skateboard area. There are also swimming pools, picnic areas and, of course, the beach – a three-quarter-mile-long expanse of beautiful white sand and dunes. Now featuring a new 9-Hole Pitch and Putt.

Wantagh Park

Wantagh | 1 King Road | 516-571-7460 | Just South of Merrick Road

This 111-acre park is one of the oldest in the Nassau County parks system, and one of the most beautiful, bordered on the south by Flat Creek with the East Bay beyond. The park has several baseball and athletic fields, a large playground area, tennis and basketball courts, a 2-mile fitness trail incorporating a variety of exercise stations, and walking paths along the scenic bay. The spectacular summer "water theme" park incorporates an Olympic-size pool, two 32-foot water slides, diving, "kiddie" and training pools, and an interactive water-play area. Now featuring a new 18-Hole Mini Golf Course.
