FY 13 Sales Tax

Year-to-date sales tax collections total \$317.7 million. This is an increase of \$25.5 million, or 8.7%, over the receipts through the same year to date period last year. However, on a check to check basis, the May 10, 2013 check is down 3.1% compared to the same check dated last year. To achieve the 2013 sales tax budget, a growth of roughly 2.7% for the rest of the year will be required. The chart below details the year to date gross sales tax receipts through May 10, 2013 compared to the same period last year.
