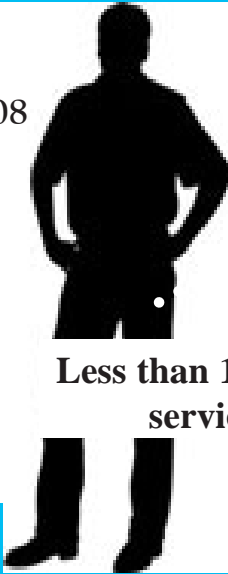

\$123 M



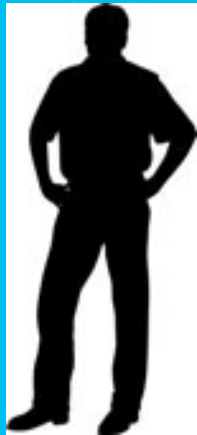
