June 16, 2004	Informational Session	Participants learned about planning grant criteria, the planning team and strategy. NYSEMO spoke about hazard mitigation and presented an overview of the County's grant, the planning process, and explained the difference between mitigation project grants versus mitigation planning grants. Because several in attendance were attending for the first time, the agenda contained a brief overview of the project and planning team structure, highlight DMA 2000 and criteria for participation and for grant eligibility as well as a summary of the completed hazard identification and profile steps. Questions were answered regarding the process for requesting assistance from higher levels of government if a disaster were to occur in a local jurisdiction. The process for developing local mitigation strategies was discussed, in response to questions. Discussion of difficulties in getting local jurisdictions on board, consistently over time, for a multi-jurisdictional process. Discussion of requirements for outreach. Questions re: liability for a jurisdiction that may have hazards identified but who may assign a low priority to mitigation actions for that hazard. Eligible types of projects for grant applications when the plan is approved. Discussion re: Guidance Memos, and low response in return of Hazard ID Questionnaires.

Extended deadlines for completion and submittal of Hazard ID Questionnaire, Outreach Logs, and Capability Assessments due to low feedback to date. Team voted on 'freezing' hazards considered to those currently identified, due to approaching deadlines (new hazards could be added during the maintenance cycles if need be). The team discussed and voted upon an approach for the plan maintenance process, including involving the public and other stakeholders in plan maintenance. Team also discussed and voted upon plan integration procedures.
June 6, 2006	Planning Group Meeting #3	Questions were invited on Interim Deliverables distributed on May 30th (Hazard ID and Profile, Asset Identification and Characterization, Damage Estimates, Land Uses and Development Trends, Capabilities, and Actions); however, no questions were posed. The remainder of the meeting was divided into two parts. In the first part, the consultant presented an overview of key risks (summary of jurisdictional vulnerability to hazards, assets in hazard areas, and NYSDOT drainage problem areas in Nassau County. The second part of the meeting, participating jurisdictions were walked through a process of evaluating and prioritizing hazard mitigation actions to address identified risks, and to developing a hazard mitigation strategy for implementing selected action items.
