IMPORTANT DATES

The 2012 Spring session is approaching and we look forward to having all of you come join us. For your convenience, all important dates regarding the registration process for this upcoming session are below. Please inquire at the front desk or on our website for detailed lottery procedures.

Mon., Feb. 6th: Schedule is released and lottery applications begin to be accepted for youth swim lessons. All lottery registrations are final after they are entered into the system. Please make sure you double check your choices and confirm you are entering the correct level.

Sun., Feb. 12th: Lottery applications due by 5 pm.

Mon., Feb. 13th: Adult swim lessons, aquatic fitness, land fitness & lifestyle class registration starts at 8 am, building opens at 6 am. No lottery for these classes - registration is first come, first serve.

Tue., Feb. 14th : Lottery results available at 9 am – Payment for class spots will be accepted starting today. Payment hours are 9 am-8 pm weekdays and 9 am-5 pm on weekends. **Important Note:** enrollee is responsible for finding out if child won a class spot from the lottery. We will not call you. Please call 572-0501 for results.

Sun., Feb. 19th: Payment for class spots is due by 5 pm. Any unpaid spots will be released to waitlisted enrollees.

Tue., Feb. 21st: Waitlist people will start to be called to fill in unpaid spots. **Note:** don't call us; you will receive a call if a spot is available. Please make sure your correct phone number is in the computer system.

Fri., Feb. 24th: Last chance open registration begins at 8 am for any remaining class spots. The availability of remaining classes will be made public the day before at 5 pm.

Mon., March 5th: First day of classes for the Spring session.
