<u>Narrative</u>

<u>Purpose</u>: This contract is to provide the necessary labor and materials associated with the efficiency improvements to the Sludge Dewatering Systems at the Cedar Creek Water Pollution Control Plant. The principal features of the work to be performed under this contract consist of furnishing and installation of new plant equipment, and associated electrical and instrumentation.

<u>Discussion</u>: The existing sludge dewatering equipment, belt filter presses, is capable of dewatering sludge to a maximum 18% solids, whereas the proposed centrifuge dewatering equipment will be able to achieve dewatered sludge in the 24%-26% range. The increased solids percentage results in a reduced sludge volume for disposal thus reducing disposal and fees.

Impact on Funding: The contract provides for the expenditure of \$3,424,400.00. Funding will be provided through an existing Capital Project No. 3C067. Bids were opened on January 19, 2016; and, RJ Industries, Inc. was accepted as the lowest responsible bidder.

Recommendation: It is recommended that this contract be approved as submitted.

On January 19, 2016, Nassau County Department of Public Works (NCDPW) received six bids for the above referenced project. Camp Dresser McKee & Smith (CDM Smith) has performed a bid analysis of the bids received. Below is our summary of the analysis, references, and recommendation.





EXECUTIVE ORDER PURSUANT TO SECTION 203 OF THE COUNTY GOVERNMENT LAW OF NASSAU COUNTY TO FURTHER DISCLOSURE BY THOSE DOING BUSINESS WITH NASSAU COUNTY

WHEREAS, pursuant to subdivision 1 of section 203 of the Nassau County Charter, the County Executive is responsible for the administration of all departments, offices and functions of the county government; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive, in furtherance of his duties pursuant to subdivision 1 of section 203, is committed to ensuring transparency and openness with respect to the administration of governmental functions; NOW, THEREFORE BE IT

ORDERED, every lobbyist, as defined on the attached <u>Lobbyist Registration and Disclosure Form</u> (hereinafter "Lobbytst Form"), shall annually file the Lobbyist Form with the County Attorney and with the Clerk of the Nassan County Legislature for each calendar year, provided, however, that the filing of such statement of registration shall not be required of any lobbyist who in any year does not earn or incur an amount in excess of one thousand dollars reportable compensation and expenses for the purposes of lobbying, or is an officer, director, trustee or employee of any public corporation when acting in such official capacity; and it is faither

ORDERED, that such filing shall be completed on or before January fifteenth by those persons who have been retained, employed or designated as lobbyists on or before December thirty-first of the previous calendar year who reasonably anticipate that in the coming year they will earn or incur combined reportable compensation and expenses in an amount in excess of one thousand dollars; and for those lobbyists retained, employed or designated after December thirty-first, and those lobbyists who, subsequent to their retainer, employment or designation, reasonably anticipate combined reportable compensation and expenses in excess of such amount, such filing must be completed within fifteen days thereafter; and it is further

ORDERED, that the County Attorney shall forward copies of each Lobbyist Form to the Nassau County Department of Information Technology ("IT"), and that IT shall develop and maintain a lobbyist registration page on that County's website, and make available all such Lobbyist Forms for public inspection on the County's website; and it is further

ORDERED, that upon termination of a lobbyist's retainer, employment or designation, such lobbyist and the client, if any, on whose behalf such service has been rendered shall both give notice to the County Attorney in the electronic filing system within thirty days after the lobbyist ceases the activity that required such lobbyist to file a statement of registration; however, such lobbyist shall nevertheless comply with the reporting requirements as set forth above and the reporting requirements for the last periodic reporting period up to the date such activity has ceased; and it is further

ORDERED, any lobbyist required to file a Lobbying Form as set forth herein who, in any lobbying year, carns or incurs combined reportable compensation and expenses in an amount in excess of one thousand dollars, for the purpose of lobbying, shall file with the County Attorney periodic reports, on forms prescribed by the County Attorney, by the fifteenth day next succeeding the end of the reporting period on which the cumulative total for such lobbying year equaled such sum. Such reporting periods shall be the period from January 1 to March 31, April 1 to May 31, June 1 to August 31 and August 31 to December 31; and it is further

ORDERED, that any lobbyist making a report pursuant to the above paragraph shall thereafter file with the County Attorney, on forms prescribed by the County Attorney, a periodic report for each reporting period that such person earns or incurs combined reportable compensation and expenses in an amount in excess of one thousand dollars for the purposes of lobbying during such reporting period. Such report shall be filed not later than the fifteenth day next succeeding the end of such reporting period and shall include the amounts so earned or

incurred during such reporting period and the cumulative total during the lobbying year, and it is further

ORDERED, that IT shall ensure that the Lobbying Form and the form for periodic reports prescribed by the County Attorney are available on the County website; and it is further

Project Specific Addendum to the Project Labor Agreement Dated May 18, 2011

Between Nassau County and the Nassau Suffolk Building and Construction Trades Council and their Affiliated Local Construction Trades Unions

This addendum relates to the Nassau County Department of Public Works (NCDPW), Cedar Creek Water Pollution Control Plant (WPCP) - Energy Efficiency Capital Improvement – Sludge Reduction Project, Construction Contract No. S3C067-06G and located in Nassau County, New York and under the conditions and requirements of the PLA referenced above.

1. Project Name:

NCDPW, Cedar Creek WPCP - Efficiency Capital Improvement Program - Sludge Reduction Project, Contract No. S3C067-06G.

2. Project Description:

NCDPW owns and operates the Cedar Creek WPCP on the south shore of Long Island. The Cedar Creek WPCP is a 72-mgd secondary treatment facility located in Wantagh, NY, Town of Hempstead. An upgrade program is underway at the Cedar Creek WPCP to address operational upgrades and system improvements. One objective of the Efficiency Capital Improvements Program is to implement a Sludge Reduction Project at the Cedar Creek WPCP to reduce operating costs and improve overall operational reliability.

The Work to be performed under this contract consists of furnishing a new Sludge Dewatering Facility. The project includes, but is not limited to, site preparation, temporary staging, facility installation, , demolition of existing equipment (belt filter presses, sludge feed pumps, polymer feed pumps, and appurtenances), installation of new mechanical equipment (including polymer feed pumps and dewatering centrifuges), as well as associated structural, instrumentation and electrical improvements at the Cedar Creek WPCP.

In general, the Work specified in the Contract Documents is typical for the construction of a new Sludge Dewatering Facility, as it requires labor forces with special skills and specific engineering expertise in the design and construction of same.

The construction schedule is 457-calendar days from issuance of the Notice to Proceed. The construction cost is estimated to be approximately \$6.1 million, of which labor costs are \$1.3 million or approximately 21% of the construction cost. In addition, it is estimated that approximately 13,000 labor hours will be expended for the construction work.

3. Feasibility Study:

In November 2015, the NCDPW engaged Camp Dresser McKee & Smith to prepare a PLA Feasibility Study to determine if the development and implementation of a PLA for the Project would provide be a benefit to the County with respect to time, cost and quality of work. As a result, the feasibility study determined that through a PLA, there is a potential savings of \$261,900 that would be realized or approximately 4.2% of the total construction cost. The feasibility study also determined that utilizing a PLA should provide for cooperation between labor trades, eliminate potential strikes, labor disputes and job actions, standardize working conditions, expedite the resolution of grievances and jurisdictional disputes, increase competitive bidding and generally level the trade labor participation for the Project.

4. PLA Administrator:

The construction manager for the Project will administer the PLA for the Project.

5. Wicks Law:

The General Construction Contract (Contract No. S3C067-06G) will be executed as single prime contract as part of the Master PLA.

6. Project Engineer and Construction Manager:

Camp Dresser McKee & Smith in association with Savin Engineers are the Project Engineer for the Project. Construction Management for the Project has not been designated as of the date of this Addendum.

7. PLA Adjustments:

The following Article shall be added to the Contract Agreement:

"Article XIV, Workers Compensation ADR - The parties may negotiate regarding the application of a Workers Compensation Alternate Dispute Resolution (ADR) program on a Project wide basis with the option of individual Union affiliates to opt out at their discretion. Notwithstanding the status of any of these negotiations, the remainder of this Agreement will remain in full force and effect."
