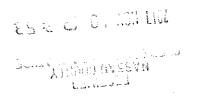

This transfer appropriates \$5,300,000 in funding to cover salary shortfall in the Police Headquarters' Salary line. \$4,100,000 of the total \$5,300,000 is being transferred to a special account in order to make the transfer from the General Fund to the Police Headquarters' fund. A supplemental appropriation is being submitted simultaneously which is part of transferring the appropriations between funds to cover the VSIP.

Impact on Funding: These transfers have no impact on the overall budget as it represents the transfer of existing funds within the same department/General Fund.

AN ORDINANCE supplemental to the annual appropriation ordinance in connection with the Police Headquarters Fund and a transfer of appropriations.

WHEREAS, Nassau County has received certain revenue; and

WHEREAS, such sums have not been otherwise appropriated; and

WHEREAS, the County Executive, by communication dated November 2, 2017 addressed to the County Legislature, has recommended the appropriation of such sums not otherwise appropriated and requested the simultaneous transfer of such sums between budgetary funds; and,

WHEREAS, this simultaneous supplemental appropriation and transfer of appropriations is within the scope of Section 307 of the County Government Law; and

WHEREAS, in order to accomplish the aforementioned supplemental appropriation, it is necessary that the simultaneous transfer of the subject sums between budgetary funds occur; and

WHEREAS, the simultaneous transfer and supplemental appropriation has been reviewed and approved by the Office of Management and Budget and the Office of the County Executive now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of the County of Nassau, as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby a transfer of appropriations within the budget year 2017 which is known as BT-38 and will be as follows:

§3. This ordinance may be modified to allow for the correction of any mathematical and/or typographical errors subsequent to any approval and adoption of said ordinance without the necessity for a vote to be taken by the County Legislature or by the members of any Standing

Committee of said Legislature if said ordinance is passed by the affirmative vote of a majority of said Legislature.

§ 4. It is hereby determined, pursuant to the provisions of the State Environmental Quality Review Act, 8 N.Y.E.C.L. section 0101 et seq. and its implementing regulations, Part 617 of 6 N.Y.C.R.R., and Section 1611 of the County Government Law of Nassau County, that this supplemental appropriation ordinance is a "Type II" Action within the meaning of Section 617.5(c)(20) of 6 N.Y.C.R.R. ("routine or continuing agency administration and management, not including new programs or major reordering of priorities that may affect the environment"), and, accordingly, is of a class of actions which do not have a significant effect on the environment; and no further review is required.

§ 5. This ordinance shall take effect immediately.

Purpose:

To supplementally appropriate funds into the following department as per the attached ordinance and back-up materials.

Police Headquarters - Salaries	\$4,100,000.00

Discussion:

This proposed ordinance includes the following supplemental appropriation, the back-up memoranda for which are annexed hereto according to the following index:

a). Police Headquarters' Salaries

This item appropriates \$4,100,000.00 in funds from the General Fund to the Interfund Account in the Police Headquarters' Fund and then transfers this amount into the Police Headquarters' salaries line. This supplemental appropriation is a part of the total \$5,300,000 transfer to Police Headquarters' salaries. This supplemental appropriation is being submitted along with a board transfer to appropriate funds in Police Headquarters fund from the General Fund. It is required in order for PDH to function for the remainder of the year. It is a final step in a 3-step process for transferring funds between the two funds.

Impact on Funding:

These supplemental appropriations will have no net impact on the budget since they will recognize an equal amount of revenue and expenditure.
