- (k) A Contractor shall maintain Documentation Demonstrating Best Efforts to Obtain Certified Minority or Women-owned Business Enterprises for a period of six (6) years. 

Lt, In regards to the conversation on the recent purchase request for new precision rifles:

- 1. The purchase request was for a complete Precision Rifle "System". Not Al A Carte for several reasons:
- a. The precision rifle system is based on the sum of its parts. The rifle is the basic platform. The integration of high quality accessories completes the "Precision Rifle". The speced out Rifle "system" is a combination of the precision rifle and its accessories. These have been carefully selected and tested, by the vendor to provide optimum performance. The vendor then carefully installs all of the accessories and tests them before delivery. The vendor then fully supports the rifle by the purchasing department. This will include almost all problems during the implementation/ deployment and through the rifle's service life. The vendor warranties the "entire rifle system". (Investigation has shown the vendor has an impeccable record for support of LE).

b.There are no members in the NCPD (BSO of the NCPD FTU) who are qualified to prepare a precision rifle system. This raises liability issues for the department and the people we serve. With such as precision rifle system the only qualified assemblers would be the manufacturer.

- *** The purchase request for these rifles were initially submitted as overall weapon systems request and at the request of Nassau County the request was broken down item by item to show the overall parts going into the system. It was not intended to create line item requests.
- 2. Because the request was for an integrated "Weapon System" line items vendors will not be able to provide a complete system. Warranties would not be covered by one vendor but would be subject to many different manufacturers and their own individual guidelines. Therefore increasing the likelihood of delays with support/ repair. Rifles would be kept out of service longer increasing the danger to our Precision Firearms Team which may rely on that capability.
