8 84-18. Clerk item 84-18 is a local law to
9 amend Nassau County administrative code in
10 relation to a partial real property tax
11 exemption for persons who render military
12 service to the United States during the Cold
13 War as authorized by Section 458-6 of the
14 New York State Real Property Tax Law.

16 LEGISLATOR WALKER: So moved.

17 LEGISLATOR RHOADS: Second.

18 CHAIRMAN FORD: Thank you
19 Legislator Walker, seconded by Legislator
20 Rhoads. The item is before us.

21 The legislation before this
22 committee does not really extend the Cold
23 War veterans exemption in its present form.

24 Instead, it increases both the
25 exemption's term from ten years to the

2 number of years a Cold War veteran owns a
3 qualifying property.

4 It's maximum amounts of \$50,000
5 to \$75,000 for the partial exemption and
6 \$180,000 to \$250,000 for the additional
7 exemption.
