- 11 responses.

- 14 work on this particular area because I think
- 15 there are several water districts in my
- 16 legislative district that must have to test
- 17 that water on a continuous basis. I am in
- 18 constant contact with the water districts as
- 19 I know you are. So I just want to thank you
- 20 for that.
