Narrative

Purpose: To authorize and award a purchase order for a tow truck for the Nassau County, Dept. of Public Works.

Discussion: This solicitation was advertised in Newsday and posted to the Nassau County Bid Solicitation Board where seven (7) vendors viewed the bid. Minority Affairs received a copy. One (1) vendor submitted a bid, Syosset Truck Sales. Syosset Truck Sales is located in Nassau County.

Impact on Funding: The maximum amount authorized under this purchase order is One Hundred Seventy-Three Thousand, Nine Hundred Dollars (\$173,900.00) from capital funds for a tow truck.

Recommendation: Office of Purchasing recommends an award to Syosset Truck Sales, as the lowest responsible vendor meeting specifications.

22' CARRIER BODY SPECIFICATIONS - 2020 Model year

1.0 INTENT

These specifications describe the necessary requirements for the furnishing of a 22' hydraulic carrier body as further described herein:

General Requirements: The unit and all associated equipment shall be furnished and complete and ready for use. The unit and all equipment shall be the manufacturer's latest model and design, and shall meet all of the minimum requirements of this specification. This vehicle will be used to transport automobiles, vans, and light trucks weighing up to 12,000 lbs. To be installed on a 37,000 lb GVW chassis, 156"CA dimension, Allison automatic transmission, air suspension further described in detailed chassis specifications provided. The carrier shall be used continuously year round in all weather conditions and be subjected to the most severe service. The prime contractor, manufacturers and subcontractors must use materials and design practices that are the best in the industry. The components used must be selected to give the utmost performance, service life and safety, and meet the minimum requirements of this specification. The carrier equipment provided is expected to have a minimum useful service life of ten (10) years.

2.0 <u>HYDRAULIC CARRIER BODY</u> - (20,000 lb. structural body rating)

The carrier body shall be 22' feet long and have a width (OD) not to exceed 102 inches. The deck shall be constructed of 3/16" diamond steel plate flooring. Portable open tube side rails constructed of 2" x 2" tubing, 5" high shall be provided. These rails shall end approximately 24" from the rear of the body to allow for easy securement of dual tire vehicles. Cab protector shall include a tapered headboard to be utilized as a light-bar pylon and to contain a mesh window insert. This cab protector headboard shall be permanently affixed to the carrier body.

A double plated approach plate shall be provided. The main rail shall be a 6" "H" beam. Main body cross members ribs shall be installed 8" apart and constructed of 3" structural channel iron. Four (4) 3/8" reinforced rear keyhole slots, two (2) forward tie down slots, and four (4) mid body double cut slots shall be provided. Two (2) one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$ ") inch thick positive front locks shall be included. The carrier body shall slide on full length replaceable polymer wear strips. To be Weld Built model TB 200S or approved equal.

The Hydraulic system shall provide a factory preset pressure not to exceed 2,500 lbs. per square inch (P.S.I.) and shall include a nineteen (19) gallon hydraulic oil reservoir with an oil level sight gauge, a breather and a return filter with a spin on type oil cartridge. Dual control stations shall be provided, one (1) on each side of the body. One (1) five spool monoblock valve body with built-in

load relief valves, hard chrome plated precision ground spools for maximum wearable and high tensile cast iron bodies shall be provided. A permanent valve

shield shall protect the controls. All moving hoses and wire harnesses shall be encased in a protective cat-trac system for longer life expectancy. The entire hydraulic operation will be powered by means of a power take-off attached to the transmission. If Allison automatic transmission is supplied, the PTO must be "Hotshift" type. A cab switch and warning light shall be installed in the cab.

Hydraulic hose connectors must be "Weatherhead" or equal. All hydraulic hoses must be routed as far as possible from the exhaust system, but be accessible for replacement.

Cylinders: Two (2) double acting hydraulic lift cylinders with hard chrome plated rods and positive locks shall be provided. The cylinders shall have a minimum stroke of not less than eighteen (18) inches and must contain a safety check valve. One (1) double acting hydraulic slide cylinder with hard chrome plate rod shall also be provided. This cylinder shall be approximately 130" in length to provide an appropriate approach angle. The body shall slide on stationary lubricated rails to assure an even distribution of loads at all times. Full -length replaceable nylatron wear strips shall be affixed to the upper body slide rails to facilitate body movement. All hydraulic cylinders'used for raising, lowering, extending, retracting will be the double acting type. The cylinders must be able to hold the loads even when the PTO is not engaged.

Hydraulic winch: A winch, having a capacity of not less than twelve thousand (12,000) pounds, with a self locking worm, automatic brake and free wheeling drum shall be provided. Fifty (50) feet of 7/16" cable with swivel hook shall be supplied and installed on the drum. A winch cable tensioner shall be provided to help keep the cable neat on the drum. The winch freewheel mechanism shall contain an extended handle for easy driver access.

3.0 WHEEL-LIFT APPARATUS

A heavy duty wheelift apparatus shall be installed at the rear of the carrier body and shall have a minimum lift rating of 4,000 pounds. The wheelift apparatus shall be independent and shall raise and lower independently of the carrier body by means of twin lift cylinders with a positive locking valve and a single telescopic cylinder. The portable wheelift slider arms shall be removable to allow the crossbar to be utilized as a conventional tow bar if desired. The wheelift payload shall be secured to the vehicle by means of L arms, retainer straps, ratchets, and additional safety chains. Controls for the operation of the wheelift will be mounted on both sides of the body. The dual rear positioned control stations for all hydraulic functions must be positioned to allow the operator full view of all loading and unloading procedures. 4.0 LIGHTING

Federal light package #108 shall be provided. To be LED lighting. This is to include body turn signals, backup lights, three (3) bar cluster and body marker lights. One (1) pair of LED work lights shall be installed next to the winch to illuminate the body area. An additional pair of LED work lights shall be installed at the rear underbody to illuminate the wheelift hook-up area, and a third pair on the light pylon. Each pair of work lights shall have a separate switch with all lighting mounted to a dash mounted Whelen switch panel. All pylon wiring shall be protected by installing stainless cover plates on the inside wall of the pylon.

An Whelen LED barlight with clear lens shall be mounted in the center of the pylon bracket, and wired to the cab switches provided. This barlight shall contain LED flashing lights plus LED stop/tail/turn signal lights. Two (2) flashing Whelen LED warning lights shall also be installed in the front grille and two at the rear of the body area to provide additional protective safety lighting. Colors of flashing warning lights to be discussed with department personnel.

A rear receptacle for auxiliary lights shall be installed in the rear plate to provide stop, tail, turn lights to the vehicle in tow. LED magnetic tow lights with a 25' of cables are to be supplied.

The carrier body shall contain 5 LED marker lights along each side rail. Three (3) additional LED marker lights shall be provided on each side of the light pylon panel. An LED ID cluster light shall also be installed on the rear body stabilizer leg. All rear underbody lighting shall installed in marine grade stainless steel light housings.

An independent LED control light, to illuminate each control station for nighttime operation shall be provided. Light shall be activated only when the PTO is engaged.

5.0 Additional Items – Vehicle shall also be equipped with the following:

Accessory chains: A four point carrier tie down package and a hookup "V" bridle shall be supplied for securing the vehicle payload to the carrier platform. Two additional tow chains with J hooks and two safety chains in rear body safety chain pockets shall also be supplied.

Front Pushplate: A custom front pushplate shall be provided and installed on the front of the vehicle. This assembly shall include black polyethylene sheeting on the pushing surface and lighted guide posts at the outer ends.

Mud flaps:

Mud flaps shall be supplied front and rearward of the chassis rear wheels.

Pintle / Ball Hitch:
