Contract Summary

Purpose: This is a contract for Palace Electrical Contractors, Inc. to provide electrical construction services for the repair installation of HVAC and fire alarm equipment at the NCPD Bellmore Highway Patrol Facility.

Method of Procurement: A request for sealed bids was advertised in Newsday on 11/6/2019, and in eprocure and NYS Contract Reporter from 11/6/2019 through 12/10/2019. Sealed bids were opened on 12/10/2019.

Procurement History: One firm submitted a sealed bid. Palace Electric was the lowest responsible bidder.

Description of General Provisions: The work to be provided includes providing electrical construction services for the installation of HVAC equipment at the NCPD Bellmore Highway Patrol Facility. The current HVAC equipment is in need of renovation. In addition, the current fire alarm system can no longer be repaired and is no longer in production and will be replaced by a new fire alarm system.

Impact on Funding / Price Analysis: The maximum amount of this contract is \$277,000

The referenced contract for the NCPD Bellmore Highway Patrol Building HVAC and Fire Alarm Renovations was advertised for bid in Newsday on November 6, 2019 and was available for pick-up on November 8, 2019. It was advertised in e-procure and Contract Reporter from November 6, 2019 to December 10, 2019. Bids were opened for this project on December 10, 2019, with only one (1) contractor turning in a bid. Twenty-eight (28) vendors were notified on e-procure. (Viewed the solicitation.) Four (4) picked up the bid package.

The bid itself was not restricted to specialized electrical contractors.

Other issues that contractors have raised are: The amount of time it takes to get a contract after a bid is opened, and the amount of time it takes to get paid after submitting a claim. (As well as the paperwork/documentation required concerning billing.)

The following are the questions from the Low Vendor Participation memo dated May 23, 2018, from Deputy County Executive John Chiara, with responses.

- 1) Review the specification to ensure that it is not unduly restrictive so as to limit competition. Is any component of the solicitation so restrictive that only one or a small number of vendors is capable of responding to the solicitation? If so, were those vendors notified of the solicitation? Response: the bid was not restrictive.
- 2) Was the solicitation advertised and posted on the County website as required? *Response: yes.*
- 3) Would we be likely to obtain greater vendor participation by advertising in other venues (e.g. New York State Contract Reporter, trade journals, other local media, etc.)? *Response: the RFPs were advertised on NYSCR and Newsday.*
- 4) Was the NIGP commodity code used to conduct the solicitation appropriate?
