- 14 has a federal grant to address safety issues.
- 15 This project is no cost to the county.
- 16 LEGISLATOR MUSCARELLA: Do we
- know exactly what they're proposing to do?
- MR. ARNOLD: Preemption. So
- they're going to coordinate signals with the
- 20 dropping of the arms. So it will be a
- 21 preemption to make it operate more effectively
- 22 and safely for the railroad.
