The first item is clerk item number 156 of '21. It's a resolution authorizing the county of Nassau to participate in a transportation project providing for Cutter Mill Road, slash, Bayville Avenue Bridge over Long Island Railroad rehabilitation, PIN 0761.19 DIN 3364560 and authorizing the county executive of the county of Nassau to execute the agreement on behalf of the county with the New York State Department of Transportation for the advancement of said aid for transportation projects in Nassau County, New York.

I have a motion please by Legislator Schaefer. Seconded by Legislator Drucker. The item is now before us. Do we have someone here from the administration?

MR. ARNOLD: Yes, we do. Ken Arnold, Public Works. Item 156 is a New York State master agreement to reimburse the county 80 percent for the associated project at Cutter Mill Road Bridge in Great Neck Plaza. The total project cost is $\$ 4$ million of which 3.2 will be reimbursed.

The first item on the addendum is clerk item 161 of '21, which is a resolution authorizing the county executive of the county of Nassau to execute on behalf of the county of Nassau an agreement with the Long Island Railroad in relation to the design, construction, installation and maintenance of additional grade crossing protection devices at the Atlantic Avenue railroad crossing in the hamlet of Oceanside.

MR. ARNOLD: This is an MOU
between the county and the Long Island
Railroad associated with improvements for Long Island Railroad grade crossing on Atlantic Avenue or the Long Beach branch. The railroad has a federal grant to address safety issues. This project is no cost to the county.

LEGISLATOR MUSCARELLA: Do we
know exactly what they're proposing to do?
MR. ARNOLD: Preemption. So,
they're going to coordinate signals with the dropping of the arms. So it will be a preemption to make it operate more effectively and safely for the railroad.

you. Any questions from the legislators? Any public comment? All those in favor please say
