LEGISLATOR KENNEDY: Here. MR. PULITZER: We have a quorum. LEGISLATOR KENNEDY: May I have a motion to suspend the rules. Moved by Legislator Walker. Seconded by Legislator Lafazan. The rules have been susppended. There is one item on the agenda today which is clerk item 3-22. Clerk item $3-22$ is an ordinance to be known as the Hiring Our Heroes Act amending Section 6 of Ordinance 180-2016 to exempt active duty and military veterans from the payment of civil service examination fees.

May I have a motion. Moved by
Legislator Walker. Seconded by Legislator DeRiggi-Whitton. Legislator Lafazan sorry. The item is before us.

Active duty military and veterans have selflessly served our nation by fighting for freedom and protecting all who live within its borders. These brave men and women, as well as their families, have made countless sacrifices so we can continue to live freely and peacefully within our great nation.

Further, active duty military and veterans receive exceptional training where discipline, leadership, grit and unparalleled work ethic have been instilled within its participants. As a result, active duty military and veterans utilize these skills in their respective careers outside the military.

Accordingly, it is within the best interests of Nassau County to encourage active duty military and veterans to pursue a career in public service. This ordinance exempts active duty military and veterans from paying the Nassau County civil service exam fees which provides such encouragement.

This ordinance was initially introduced by Legislator Lafazan and is now cosponsored by the remaining members of the Nassau County Legislature.

Is there any debate or discussion? Yes, Legislator Lafazan.

LEGISLATOR LAFAZAN: Thank you
Legislator Kennedy. I was proud to support this bill called the Hiring Our Heroes Act and I want to specifically thank my Republican

colleagues in the legislature. There has been a consistent bipartizan committment in supporting our veterans. I know it will continue in the session, so thank you for your support. I know I have worked with Legislator Gaylor, who is a veteran himself, and I thank him as well.

19 million Americans are veterans and 55,000 of those veterans live right here in Nassau County. Our veterans are truly amongst the greatest citizens of us and we owe them a debt of gratitude that we can never repay.

Yet, our commitment to our veterans does not end when they take off their uniform. This commitment is lifelong, it's enduring and it's iron clad. And it's in this vein that we have to do better as a country, as a state and as a county in serving those veterans. 581,000 veterans were unemployed in the year 2020 and this number continues to rise as we deal with COVID-19.

The Hiring Our Heroes Act will exempt veterans and active duty service

members from civil service examination fees. As we heard directly from veterans themselves, this will open the door to employment here in Nassau County, encourage more veterans to join our workforce. And as statistics show, veterans make some of the best employees in the workforce today.

So, I thank my Republican colleagues for their support and I look forward to getting this bill signed into law. Thank you.
