- ordinance as stated for funding from New York

- 9 applicant. Previously we were in front of you
- 10 regarding ARP money. It's going to be used
- 11 for the balance of that grant.

- ten for a total of 20?
- MR. ARNOLD: I believe it's ten
- 15 and ten for a total of 20.
- 16 LEGISLATOR GAYLOR: This second
- bill here, 27-22, are those funds limited to
- 18 just the north shore septic system program or
- 19 it's all throughout the county including the
- 20 barrier islands and the south shore or there's
- 21 no distinction?
- 22 MR. ARNOLD: I believe there's no
- 23 distinction.
- LEGISLATOR GAYLOR: Very good.
- 25 Is there any debate or discussion amongst the

- 4 Chair. Just one question Ken. The \$4.3
- 5 million that's being appropriated to NICE bus,

- 8 in terms of their financial needs and capital
- 9 needs?
- 10 MR. ARNOLD: I believe this is
- 11 expected grant money that we receive every
- 12 year from the state for capital and capital
- 13 maintenance for their facilities. This is
- 14 part of our annual take of federal and state
- 15 funding.
