2 LEGISLATOR GAYLOR: Call the
3 Public Works Committee to order. I'll ask the
4 clerk to call the roll.

5 MR. PULITZER: Public Works roll
6 call. Legislator Carrie Solages.

2 MR. PULITZER: We have a quorum
3 sir.

4 LEGISLATOR GAYLOR: Thank you
5 sir. There are two items on the agenda today
6 which are clerk items numbers 12-22 and
7 27-22. Clerk item 12-22 and 27-22 are
8 ordinances supplemental to the annual
9 appropriation ordinance in connection with the
10 Department of Public Works.

11 May I have a motion. Moved by
12 Legislator John Giuffre. Seconded by
13 Legislator Laura Schaefer. Thank you. The
14 item is before us. Seeing that we have
15 Commissioner Ken Arnold from the
16 administration from DPW. Good afternoon
17 commissioner.

18 MR. ARNOLD: Good afternoon
19 committee. Item 12-22 is a supplemental bond
20 ordinance as stated for funding from New York
21 State for \$4.4 million that will be utilized
22 to capital-related expenses for our TransDev
23 bus operation.

24 LEGISLATOR GAYLOR: That covers
25 both of them?

2 MR. ARNOLD: The second item,
3 which is 27-22, a supplemental appropriation
4 for \$2 million from funding that the county is
5 receiving from the Environmental Facilities
6 Corporation to be used for our septic
7 replacement program. These funds are 50
8 percent matched not to exceed \$10,000 for any
9 applicant. Previously we were in front of you
10 regarding ARP money. It's going to be used
11 for the balance of that grant.

12 LEGISLATOR GAYLOR: It's ten and
13 ten for a total of 20?

14 MR. ARNOLD: I believe it's ten
15 and ten for a total of 20.

16 LEGISLATOR GAYLOR: This second
17 bill here, 27-22, are those funds limited to
18 just the north shore septic system program or
19 it's all throughout the county including the
20 barrier islands and the south shore or there's
21 no distinction?

22 MR. ARNOLD: I believe there's no
23 distinction.

24 LEGISLATOR GAYLOR: Very good.
25 Is there any debate or discussion amongst the

2 legislators? Legislator Arnold Drucker.

3 LEGISLATOR DRUCKER: Thank you
4 Chair. Just one question Ken. The \$4.3
5 million that's being appropriated to NICE bus,
6 to TransDev, does that put them in a good
7 solid footing in terms of what you're aware of
8 in terms of their financial needs and capital
9 needs?

10 MR. ARNOLD: I believe this is
11 expected grant money that we receive every
12 year from the state for capital and capital
13 maintenance for their facilities. This is
14 part of our annual take of federal and state
15 funding.

16 LEGISLATOR DRUCKER: Thank you.

17 LEGISLATOR GAYLOR: Any other
18 legislators? Any public comment? There being
19 none, all in favor signify by saying aye. Any
20 opposed? These two items pass unanimously.

21 There being no other business
22 before this committee, may I have a motion to
23 adjourn. Motion by Legislator Kennedy.
24 Seconded by Legislator Bynoe. All in favor?
25 This committee is now adjourned.
