14 County Department of Health. Item 86-22 is a
15 supplemental appropriation for the bathing
16 beach water quality monitoring and
17 notification program in the amount of
18 \$58,350. This is a New York State Department
19 of Health funding and mandated through the New
20 York State sanitary code. This program
21 provides beach water quality monitoring in 56
22 permanent beaches in the county. Public
23 notification is required of beach closures and
24 openings. Any questions?
