6 Mike. We're going to start out with a motion
7 to suspend the rules because we have an
8 addendum. It is moved by Ms. Walker and
9 seconded by Mr. McKevitt. All those in favor
10 of suspending the rules please say aye. Any
11 opposed? The rules are suspended. Thank
12 you.

13 We have a number of -- most of our
14 items actually -- which have gone through
15 previous committees and are being consented to
16 by members of both majority and minority.
17 Don't require any further debate. Those
18 numbers are 139 of '22, 142, 143, 144 and
19 146. Motion by Mr. Drucker. Seconded by
20 Mr. McKevitt. All those in favor of those
21 items please say aye. Any opposed? Those
22 items are unanimous. Thank you.

23 Number 134 is a resolution
24 providing for the issuance of warrants
25 directing the treasurer to pay to the

3 cities various sums in respect to mortgage
4 taxes.

5 That motion is made by Mr. Ferretti
6 and it is seconded by Mr. Lafazan. Anyone
7 have any questions or comments with respect to

9 please say aye. Any opposed? Number 134 is
10 unanimous.

11 Number 149 on the addendum is an
12 ordinance supplemental to an appropriation
13 ordinance in connection with OMB.

14 Motion by Ms. Walker. Seconded by
15 Mr. Drucker.

16 MR. NOLAN: Chris Nolan, Office
17 of Management and Budget. Item 149-22
18 appropriates our local fiscal recovery funds
19 for a college summer intern program in the
20 amount of \$250,000. The program, which will
21 be administered by the Office of Human
22 Resources, is open to Nassau County residents
23 attending college or students attending
24 colleges in Nassau County.

25 The intent of the program will help

2 to mitigate financial barriers that an unpaid
3 internship may represent for certain students
4 and it also provides a financial incentive to
5 students to participate in a widely recognized
6 learning experience that supports degree
7 completion and future employment.

8 LEGISLATOR KOPEL: What is it
9 that we're funding?

10 MR. NOLAN: It's a paid summer
11 internship.

12 LEGISLATOR KOPEL: Where is
13 funding coming from?

14 MR. NOLAN: From the ARP funds.
15 For the local fiscal recovery funds under ARP.

16 LEGISLATOR KOPEL: Anyone else
17 have any questions?

18 LEGISLATOR FERRETTI: What's the
19 total amount?

20 MR. NOLAN: \$250,000.

21 LEGISLATOR KOPEL: Anyone else?
22 Hearing none, all those in favor of this item,
23 number 149, please say aye. Anyone opposed?
24 No one opposes. That's unanimous.
