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promotion gifts.

May I have a motion? Moved by Legislator Schaeffer, second by Legislator Drucker.

So this item is now before us. Anybody from the Administration like to tell us about this resolution?

COMMISSIONER BELYEA: Yes, good afternoon. This will designate Nassau County with Parks as our own tourism promotion agency as a short-term fix. It allows us to do two things: Allow us to receive funds from the Empire State Development, I love New York Matching Funds Grant program, to promote tourism in Nassau County. It will also allow us to receive additional stipend that we would then transfer to Discover Long Island who will use these funds along with an identical contribution from Suffolk County to conduct a regional tourism campaign on our behalf. In that campaign they will promote both counties as a region.

The County missed out in this
opportunity funding in 2022 because there
was no tourism promotion agency in place.
I didn't want to miss out on the
opportunity here again. We're in the
process of issuing an RFP for a tourism
promotion agency outside of ourselves,
and when we do issue a contract for that

agency, we can then transfer these funds

to them.

CHAIRMAN GAYLOR: Okay, good. So I think I heard you right. You'll be the lead agency, you'll collect the money and then you can designate it out to third parties.

COMMISSIONER BELYEA: Well, a portion of it. A portion were going to use inhouse and we'll match it and then 50% of it goes to Discover Long Island, who will administer the regional program for both counties.

LEGISLATOR GAYLOR: Gotcha. Is there any debate or discussion?

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with the National Parks Department and also working with the State. We're talking about tourism and things of that nature, of people coming here. For those who travel Southern State Parkway, I mean years ago we used to have that tollbooth. I'm not looking to get that back. But we did have a center. It was kind of a tourism resource center that people could maybe stop if they're not familiar with the area. That's one thing that we don't have along our roadways in Nassau County is any type of linkages. If you go on parkways, you go on the thruway, Garden State Parkway, New Jersey, they have recognition of local tourist attractions,

But we need to have some type of facility along that roadway. Again, I know that that's a state roadway, but now that we're losing someone from the County to the State, that might be something that they can also look into, Legislator

something to eat, an historic landmark.

places where people can get gas,

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Rhoads, for that additional funding to address that. Because, again, we want to put that funding to good use, but we also want to hopefully maximize those resources.

Again, we also had a location there for our state troopers. I know that they moved the facility off of Meadowbrook Parkway, but it's clear, because of the number of fatalities in the issues in that particular corridor on Southern State Parkway and now increasing Northern State Parkway, that we really need to bolster that type of support, not only for our residents, but for people who are passing through. So we want to make them more amenable for them to stop in Nassau County to get gas to get something to eat.

You know we're doing great things at Hempstead Lake State Park. I mean again, that's right off of the parkway. Let's make that more attractive and amenable for, again, residents here, so we can

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promote staycations (sic), but also for those who come through our county to go to other locations.

So I am definitely in support of this grant. But again I'm hoping that we can build on it, generate relationships, working relationships with Suffolk County, Queens and Brooklyn, so that we can make that whole transport of the 110 miles that is the width of Long Island amenable for all those who transverse on it. Thank you.
