CHAIRMAN KOPEL: Okay. We're going to start with a motion to suspend the Rules made by Mr. McKevitt and seconded by Mr. Solages. All those in favor of suspending the Rules, please say, "Aye". (Whereupon, all members of the Finance Committee respond
in favor with, "Aye".)
CHAIRMAN KOPEL: Any opposed?
(Whereupon, no verbal
response.)
CHAIRMAN KOPEL: The Rules are suspended.

We've got two Consent Items, and these two items have gone through previous Committees, and no further debate or discussion is necessary. And those would be numbers 43-23 and 44-23. Motion by Ms. Walker, seconded by Mr. Lafazan. All those in favor of 43 and 44,



CHAIRMAN KOPEL: Okay. So let's start now with number 39, which is a Resolution authorizing the County Executive to enter into and execute amendments to existing County contracts with the Nassau County Council of Chambers. And we have a motion by Mr. Ferretti, seconded by Mr. Drucker. Do we have anyone here on number 39?

MR. CHITTY: Good afternoon, legislators. My name is Lionel Chitty. I'm the executive director for the Nassau County Office of Minority Affairs. CHAIRMAN KOPEL: Yes. Tell us about the Item, please.

MR. CHITTY: The specific item is for the National County Chambers of Commerce to receive funding of $\$ 600,000$ in ARPA funding. This funding is to help support the Nassau County small businesses. This is a re-grant. The 600,000 will be going to the Nassau Council and be redistributed to all the local chambers of commerce and business

improvement districts to be able to help and technical assistance with any and all
small businesses within Nassau County.
CHAIRMAN KOPEL: Okay. Do we have any questions?
(Whereupon, no verbal
response.)
CHAIRMAN KOPEL: Hearing none. Thank
you. All those in favor of this item, please say, "Aye".
(Whereupon, all members of the Finance Committee respond in favor with, "Aye".) CHAIRMAN KOPEL: Any opposed?
(Whereupon, no verbal response.)

CHAIRMAN KOPEL: The item passes unanimously. Thank you, sir.


CHAIRMAN KOPEL: Next one is number 40, which is a Resolution providing the issuance of warrant directing the treasurer to pay the supervisors, the various towns, and villages treasurers sums apportioned by the Legislature in respect of mortgage tax. And that motion is made by Mr. McKevitt and seconded by Mr. Drucker.

I don't we don't see anyone here, but basically year over year, I believe it's down close to $40 \%$.

MS. CARLSON: Helene Carlson, Office of Legislative Budget Review. Yes. Year-to-year, it's down 39.6\%.

CHAIRMAN KOPEL: Yeah. Okay. Great news. It's not unexpected, though.

MS. CARLSON: This represents the collections from October 1st, 2022 through December 31, 2022.

CHAIRMAN KOPEL: Okay. Any questions?

CHAIRMAN KOPEL: Number 42
authorizes a transfer of appropriations.

MS. SIMONE: Ann Desimone, Health Department. Item 42-23 is a budget transfer in the amount of $\$ 1,524$ to maximize grant funding for the STD Disease Intervention Services grant.

CHAIRMAN KOPEL: Okay. No County

CHAIRMAN KOPEL: Number 50 is a Resolution authorizing the execution of an intergovernmental agreement, an IMA between Nassau County Department of Information and Technology and various agencies and the New York State of Information Technology Services and Homeland Security and Emergency Services. Number 50 motion is by Mr. Ferretti, seconded by Mr. Solages.

MR. JACOVINA: Good afternoon. Joe Jacovina, Deputy Commissioner, Information Technology. Number 50-23 is a Resolution authorizing an intergovernmental agreement on behalf of the Nassau County Department of Information Technology and various agencies in the New York State Office of Information Technology Services and the New York State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services to provide endpoint detection and response software called CrowdStrike. CrowdStrike is an EDR that provides for cyber

security wall to prevent, detect and capture malware. And EDR Endpoint

Detection and Response Tool is an
integrated approach to endpoint
protection that combines real time continuous monitoring and endpoint data analytics with rule based automated response.

I'd be happy to answer any questions you may have.

CHAIRMAN KOPEL: Okay. Number 66 is an ordinance making SEQRA determinations in respect of an amendment to an agreement with Cornell Cooperative. Motion by Mr. Drucker, seconded by Mr. Lafazan.

MR. WALSH: Good afternoon, legislators. Kevin Walsh from the Office of Real Estate Services.

This agreement is actually an
amendment to a license agreement the County has with Cornell Cooperative Extension for the East Meadow Farm on Merrick Avenue.

The amendment achieves two things. First of all, there is a portion of the property, a portion of small property adjacent to the existing site is going to be added to it. It had been the site of a small residential building we got with the open space acquisition. The building had to be raised after it had some fire damage during the pandemic. But now

Cornell plans to build a dynamic learning center there so they can further engage the community in the local schools. And they have matching grant from Covanta. Covanta is donating $\$ 400,000$ and the County will be providing matching grant funds.

Also, the amendment does extend the term for Cornell until 2040 so they can continue to fundraise and continue to provide the wonderful programs to the community.
