MS. OWEIS: Hi. Good afternoon.

Joanne Oweis, Deputy County Attorney. I'm
here on behalf of Social Services.

This item appropriates \$43,350 in funding received from New York State
Office of Children and Family Services to fund the goals, objectives and strategies for addressing the needs of commercially exploited children in Nassau County, utilizing funds being made available by by OCFS.

This is to fund our Safe Harbor project for the 2023 calendar year, and its purpose is to address the needs of commercially sexually exploited children in Nassau County, utilizing funds available from the State. It's completely funded by the State. We submitted a plan to the State in conjunction with Safe Center, who's our partner in this plan, and we ask that these funds be appropriated so we can move forward with the project.

MS. DESIMONE: Good afternoon, Ann DeSimone, Health Department. Item 120-23, a supplemental appropriation in the amount of \$453,766 for the HIV Expanded Services Grant from New York State Department of Health. This program is to reduce the spread of sexually transmitted diseases. It covers salary, fringe, general expenses and indirect costs, and the grant does not require matching funds.

CHAIRWOMAN WALKER: Okay. Thank you. Any questions From the legislators? (Whereupon, no verbal response.)

CHAIRWOMAN WALKER: Any public comment?

Just a couple of questions since all of you have the information and we, the taxpayers, just have to kind of foot the bill. I'm just a little curious about the expanded services. Like what is the

overall budget for this Department? A lot of times when I hear about grants and funding that come across this Body, the connection generally has to do with salaries and benefits. But I don't really ever hear about how much money actually is directed towards program services and catchment areas for these particular services. And just because it doesn't require a matching grant, that does not

mean that there is not a need that could

be the responsibility of this County to

address this situation.

know, none of you are asking questions, you may have all of the information, but those of us that are kind of out here on these mean streets trying to direct people to these services that they often can't get to or they don't have the facilities in their community, it makes us wonder where the actual program services and resources are for them to

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get access to it. So that would be my question to that.

CHAIRWOMAN WALKER: Ann, do you want to address?

MS. DESIMONE: Hi, Good afternoon. Yes. So our staff does put in touch about 100 to 200 clients a year that have disease and they connect them to services. So that is the job of the staff to connect them to FQHCs, any kind of other clinics that they need care, and they follow them to make sure that they have care in their areas.
