Map of the County of Nassau, and

authorizing the County Executive to

execute a deed, contract of sale and all

pertinent documents in connection

therewith to consummate the sale.

LEGISLATOR FORD: So moved.

MR. K. WALSH: Good Afternoon,

Legislators. Kevin Walsh from the Office

of Real Estate Services. This is a

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proposed transfer of a vacant piece of county property located in the Village of Great Neck. I would classify this is kind of an unofficial storm basin. It's a drainage parcel that is not needed for county purposes. The Great Neck Park District, reached out to the County, would like to acquire it for park purposes. So it will be conveyed to the Village with a restriction in the deed that it may only be used for passive park purposes available for use for all county residents.

The location of the property is between a village ice rink and a tennis facility and ball fields in the back. So they're going to clean the property up, add some trails and it'll be for the benefit of the community.

CHAIRWOMAN SCHAEFER: Great. Thank you.

Any legislators want to comment on this item? Legislator Mule.

LEGISLATGOR MULE: You mentioned

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that it would be for the use of all Nassau County residents. So, I don't know the answer to this question, but are Great Neck parks generally available to all county residents?

MR. K. WALSH: I don't know. actually have a representative of the park district here, Jason Marra. Maybe he can answer that question.

LEGISLATGOR MULE: So my real question is, how do we make sure that all county residents will know that they have use of this property?

MR. K. WALSH: I'll let him speak to it. I know there will be signage.

MR. MARRA: Hello, my name is Jason Marra, Superintendent of Great Park District. To answer your question specifically, our parks are generally for Great Neck Park District residents only. We have sites that we have staff where they have to show ID card to come in. The site of this location, as mentioned earlier, is between our ice rink and our

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tennis facility, which is open currently to all county residents. So we will have signage up and we will not be enforcing park cards for that park usage. So it is open for all county residents.

LEGISLATGOR MULE: And then will parking be available?

MR. MARRA: Yes. There is parking on-site currently. So this land is situated directly between our two recreation facilities, which there's ample parking provided.

LEGISLATGOR MULE: So the recreational facilities areas will not be available to county residents; is that correct?

MR. MARRA: No. Those two
facilities are special use facilities so
they are open to non residents of the
Park District, whereas our specific parks
in other locations are for Park District
residents only. The site of this
location, the two facilities are
currently open to Nassau County

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2	residents. So the park that would be
3	passive in between will be open to county
4	residents and we would just have general
5	park signage up indicating that.
6	LEGISLATGOR MULE: Great. And how
7	many acres are we talking about?
8	MR. MARRA: The total is 2.2.
9	LEGISLATGOR MULE: Thank you.
10	MR. K. WALSH: I just wanted to add
11	also to this. The County is also
12	reserving an easement for DPW in case we
13	do have to get into any of the drainage
14	and so forth.
