CHAIRMAN GAYLOR: Thank you. So we have two items on the agenda today, which are Clerk Items 191-23 and 196-23.

Clerk Item 191-23 is an ordinance to amend ordinance 75-2022 adopting the Capital Budget for the County of Nassau for the first year of the four-year capital plan, to commence on January 1 , 2023, pursuant to the provisions of Section 310 of the county Government Law of Nassau County.

COMMISSIONER ARNOLD: Thank you. Good afternoon. Ken Arnold, Public

Works.
Item 191 is a Capital Budget amendment to increase the non county funding in the Long Beach project in the capital plan by $\$ 28.5$ million. This is non county funding. This allows the County to enter into contracts that were previously heard today associated with the Long Beach diversion. These funds, as previous stated, are coming from FEMA to the City of Long Beach, but all contracting is being done for this project on the Department of Public Works.

COMMISSIONER BELYEA: Darcy Belyea, Parks Commissioner. Good afternoon again.

COMMISSIONER BELYEA: AS
mentioned, this is a supplemental appropriation in the amount of $\$ 300,000$. NYU Langone Health is sponsoring our summer concerts and outdoor movie series throughout our park system this summer. There is no net impact on the budget, since there
will be an equal amount of revenue and expenditure in using these funds.

Commissioner. Can you tell me what parks these concerts are going to be held at?

COMMISSIONER BELYEA: I'm going to share the schedule with everybody when I get back to the office. Largely Eisenhower Park, and then we have Wantagh Park, Cedar Creek, and Chelsea Mansion, and $I$ think that's it. Nothing at Morley this year. And North Woodmere Park.
