CHAIRMAN GAYLOR: Present.

CLERK PULITZER: We have a  
quorum, sir.

CHAIRMAN GAYLOR: Thank you. So  
we have seven items on the agenda  
today, which are Clerk Items 215-23;  
216-23; 217-23; 219-23; 230-23; 231-23  
and 232-23.

Clerk Item 215-23 is a Resolution  
declaring a capital budget emergency  
pursuant to Section 310 Subparagraph D  
of the County Government Law of Nassau  
County.

May I have a motion? Moved by  
Legislator Schaefer, seconded by  
Legislator Solages.

So the item is before us.  
Commissioner Arnold.

COMMISSIONER ARNOLD: Good  
afternoon.

So 215 sets the emergency for the  
capital plan amendment, which is 218  
and then which folds into the bond

1  
2 ordinance request, which is 217.

3 The amendment and the  
4 corresponding bond ordinance is all  
5 associated with ongoing projects that  
6 require funding to be complete bidding  
7 this year. Most particularly of note in  
8 this request is money required for the  
9 Second Precinct construction. We have  
10 money added here for Sewer  
11 Rehabilitation. We've had a few issues  
12 recently that require additional funds  
13 and then we have a lot of projects that  
14 are ready to go out to bid that require  
15 funding like the Parking Lot 14,  
16 Merrick Road pavement to name just two.

17 In total, the request for bond  
18 ordinance, which is the borrowing  
19 capacity, is General for 125 SSW, 94  
20 for a total of 219. I should also  
21 mention that SSW at 94 includes two  
22 large projects: The Cedar Creek final  
23 tanks and Cedar Creek digesters. They  
24 were in the Capital Plan Budget, but we  
25 did not ask for the bond ordinance at

1  
2 that time early in the year because  
3 they were not ready for bidding. We  
4 were also hoping at that time to find  
5 other funding sources. Since we did  
6 not, those two projects are being  
7 requested of a bond ordinance at this  
8 time.

9 CHAIRMAN GAYLOR: Okay. And all  
10 that's under 215-23?

11 COMMISSIONER ARNOLD: Well, I  
12 rolled it all together because it's one  
13 big story. Like I said, 218 is the  
14 amendment and then 217 is the bond  
15 ordinance. So they all fit together.  
16 That's what I like to present them as  
17 one story. It makes it a little  
18 simpler.

19 CHAIRMAN GAYLOR: Except we don't  
20 have 218 on the Calendar before us. So  
21 we've got 215 and 217. I'm going to  
22 just keep it at 215 for now, which  
23 really focuses on the collection  
24 system.

25 COMMISSIONER ARNOLD: So 215 is

1  
2 just declaring the emergency for the  
3 Capital Plan.

4 CHAIRMAN GAYLOR: Oh, I gotcha.  
5 Not 18, it should be 16 is what they're  
6 saying.

7 COMMISSIONER ARNOLD: Okay.

8 CHAIRMAN GAYLOR: Is there any  
9 debate or discussion?

10 (Whereupon, no verbal response.)

11 CHAIRMAN GAYLOR: Any public  
12 comment?

13 (Whereupon, no verbal response.)

14 CHAIRMAN GAYLOR: All in favor,  
15 signify by saying, "Aye". On 215 only.

5 projects identified herein within the  
6 County of Nassau, authorizing  
7 186,242,000 of bonds. The County of  
8 Nassau to finance that expenditure  
9 pursuant to Local Finance Law of New  
10 York and County Government law of  
11 Nassau County.

22 LEGISLATOR FORD: Yes.

23 CHAIRMAN GAYLOR: All right. So  
24 let me backtrack for a second.

4 within the County of Nassau and  
5 authorizing an amended amount of  
6 \$219,700,092 of bonds of the County of  
7 Nassau to finance said expenditure  
8 pursuant to Local Finance Law of New  
9 York and the County government laws of  
10 Nassau County.

11 Can I have a motion? Moved by  
12 Legislator Kennedy. Seconded by  
13 Legislator Drucker. The item is before  
14 us. Any further discussion, Ken, or you  
15 got it?

16 COMMISSIONER ARNOLD: I presented  
17 the discussion.

6 with the Department of Public Works.

11 COMMISSIONER ARNOLD: So 219-23  
12 is a supplemental appropriation to add  
13 \$100,000 from funds received by the  
14 Long Island Regional Planning Council  
15 from the New York State DEC to be  
16 utilized by the Nassau County Soil and  
17 Water Conservation District to help  
18 administer the County's septic system  
19 replacement grant program.

20 CHAIRMAN GAYLOR: All right. Any

23 LEGISLATOR SCHAEFER: Hi,  
24 Commissioner. Just a quick question. So  
25 it's the funding is for the Nassau

1  
2 County Soil and Water Conservation  
3 District, just for management of that.  
4 It's not actually coming to Nassau  
5 County.

6 COMMISSIONER ARNOLD: Well, it  
7 does flow through Nassau County. We are  
8 actually, discussing with the District  
9 whether they can have the funding  
10 flowing directly to them to eliminate  
11 this step. But currently we have the  
12 contract with the District. So we  
13 receive the money than we pay them.  
14 That's why we have to set up the  
15 supplemental appropriation.

16 LEGISLATOR SCHAEFER: Okay. Thank  
17 you.

signals on Merrick Avenue under Capital  
project T62461-01D, PIN number 07610.44

the County of Nassau to execute an  
agreement on behalf of the County with  
the New York State Department of  
Transportation for the Advancement of  
said aid for transportation projects in  
Nassau County.

COMMISSIONER ARNOLD: Okay. So  
item 230, 31, 32, 33 are all contracts  
that the County and the State enter  
into to receive funding from the TIP,  
which is the Transportation Improvement

1  
2 Plan. So in this particular case, as  
3 stated, this is for signal improvements  
4 at 23 signal locations on Merrick  
5 Avenue, the County will receive 4.25  
6 million of Federal and State funds.

7 CHAIRMAN GAYLOR: And that's  
8 under all three of these?

9 LEGISLATOR FORD: No, but they're  
10 all the same. I just want to introduce  
11 why we do these. They're all done for  
12 the same purpose. Each one's a  
13 different project.

14 CHAIRMAN GAYLOR: Okay. Any  
15 debate or discussion?

24 include Glen Cove Avenue, Franklin  
25 Avenue, Willis Avenue and New Hyde Park

1  
2 Road. We will be receiving \$6.424  
3 million from the Fed and \$1.204 million  
4 from the State.

7 cameras on various county roads under  
8 Capital Project T62565-01D, PIN 0761.43  
9 and authorizing the County Executive of  
10 the County of Nassau to execute the  
11 agreement on behalf of the County with  
12 the New York State Department of  
13 Transportation for the Advancement of  
14 said aid for Transportation projects in  
15 Nassau County, New York.

16 May I have a motion, please? So  
17 moved by Legislator Kennedy, seconded  
18 by Legislator Bynoe. Thank you. The  
19 item is before us. Commissioner Arnold.

20 COMMISSIONER ARNOLD: Okay, so  
21 232 is associated with the Department's  
22 incident cameras, installations, Phase  
23 5. For those who may not know, we have  
24 a Traffic Management Center and we have  
25 camera feeds that come into that center

1  
2 where we can make adjustments and make  
3 changes as required. This contract will  
4 add -- I don't have the the camera  
5 count -- but it's probably two dozen or  
6 so cameras throughout the county. The  
7 Federal share will be 2.9 and the State  
8 share is half \$1 million as part of  
9 this grant.

10 CHAIRMAN GAYLOR: When you say  
11 cameras, these are cameras other than  
12 the red light cameras at intersections?

13 COMMISSIONER ARNOLD: Correct.  
14 These cameras do not enforce anything.  
15 It's just information that comes back  
16 to the Traffic Management Center. And  
17 those camera feeds are also shared with  
18 the police also in case they need eyes  
19 on something.

20 CHAIRMAN GAYLOR: Okay. And these  
21 are on the road network within Nassau  
22 County?

23 COMMISSIONER ARNOLD: Yes.

24 CHAIRMAN GAYLOR: Okay. Thank  
25 you.

15 under \$1 million from the State.

5 Management Center shares the data with  
6 the Waze or the Googles of the world.  
7 And actually, we communicate with them.  
8 So I'll give you an example. Like when  
9 we have a concert at Eisenhower Park  
10 and Merrick Avenue is going to be  
11 closed, we would tell Waze of that.  
12 When we had the sinkhole like in Lido,  
13 we communicated with Waze and Google to  
14 let them know that we're doing work  
15 there. We also have camera feeds in the  
16 Center so we can see what's going on  
17 during those processes and make changes  
18 if needed. But yes, we do. We're  
19 required, I think, by accepting State  
20 and Federal money to share that data.

21 LEGISLATOR SCHAEFER: Very  
22 interesting. Thank you.

23 CHAIRMAN GAYLOR: As a follow up,  
24 we don't charge or get any money back  
25 from Waze, do we?
