23	Legislators. Seema Zaki, I'm the fiscal
24	director for Department of Human
25	Services.
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1 2 Item 341-23. There are multiple 3 appropriations which are for the mandated programs, which are 100% state and 4 5 federally funded. 6 The first appropriation is for 7 \$23,466,200. This is for the calendar year 2024. The funding that provides for 8 9 the programs is medically supervised 10 outpatient programs, gambling and 11 prevention, opioid programs, and it also 12 includes funding to the school districts. 13 The second appropriation, which is 14 again for funding received from Oasis, 15 New York State, for the fiscal year 2024, 16 is for the treatment of methadone 17 maintenance treatment for the clinic that 18 is run in Building K by the County. 19 And the third item is for 20 \$4,427,935. This is a funding received from Office of Mental Health for the 21 22 calendar year 2024. The program provides 23 a wide range of mental health and 24 chemical dependency clinic treatment 25 programs for kids.

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2	The fourth item is again for the			
3	calendar year 2024, received from New			
4	York State Office of Mental Health for			
5	\$16,259,005. These programs will be for			
6	the adult individuals for for mental			
7	health illnesses and chemical dependency			
8	disorders.			
9	The fifth item, the last one, is a			
10	cost of living increase for 2023. Again,			
11	the funding is received from Office of			
12	Mental Health for the calendar year 2023			
13	for \$286,102.
