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This is a piece of property owned by the County that is partially used by the Stratford South Pump Station. There's another portion of the property not termed for use necessary for the pump station purposes, which adjoins a shopping center which was recently purchased by the party requesting this.

The proposal was to rent a small portion of the property, like I said, not not utilized for county purposes, to the shopping center under terms and provisions, lease of approximately \$10,000 per year with 2% increases over a period of time, proper insurance indemnification to the County, some landscaping to make sure that the property is aesthetic to the residents and it meets with the appraisal requirements as to the value of the property. And that's before you. CHAIRWOMAN SCHAEFER: Thank you. And the appraisal determined the rental

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amount?

3	MR. SARANDIS: Yes, appraisal as a
4	rental. Obviously DPW, because of the
5	potential that eventually it might be
6	needed for County purposes, doesn't want
7	to sell the property. But if the County
8	were to desire to sell the property in
9	the future, the lease provides that the
10	current tenant would have a right to
11	match the price or whatever so that they
12	would get the property. It's a very small
13	portion of property. I think it's about
14	10 or 12 parking spaces for the expansion
15	of the shopping center.
