There is only one Item on the Agenda. Clerk Item 396-23, which is an ordinance supplemental to the annual appropriation ordinance in connection with the Health Department.

May I have a motion, please?

By Legislator Giangregorio, seconded by Legislator Drucker.

MS. ZOHRABIAN: Good afternoon.

Alyssa Zohrabian, Nassau County

Department of Health.

Item 396-23 contains five supplemental appropriations. The first supplemental appropriation is in the amount of \$490,000 for the STD Disease Intervention Services grant. Staff in this grant confirm the diagnosis and treatment of the infection with the health care provider. The patient is interviewed, counseled, and education is

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provided. Partner notification and referrals for testing are also provided.

The second supplemental appropriation is in the amount of \$145,955 for the Drinking Water Enhancement Grant to protect and enhance the public water supply in Nassau County, and to ensure the safety of the drinking water.

The third and fourth supplemental appropriations are in the amount of \$44,137 and \$5,978,226, respectively. And that is for the Ryan White grant. The federal government provides these funds for comprehensive health and social services for people living with HIV and AIDS in Nassau and Suffolk counties. Nassau County is the designated grantee for both counties. We contract with United Way of Long Island as technical support agency. This award also includes \$449,000 for a minority AIDS initiative to address disparities in access, treatment, and care for racial and ethnic

minorities.

And the fifth and final supplemental appropriation in this item is in the amount of \$74,425. It is a newly awarded grant from the National Association of County and City Health Officials titled Infectious Disease Outbreaks Enhancing Forecasting and Analytics Capabilities for Local Health Departments. This grant will help proactively predict and analyze disease outbreaks to better protect the public health.

All five supplemental appropriations are 100% grant funded from either New York State or from the centers for Disease Control, and will have no net impact on the budget.

CHAIRWOMAN WALKER: Thank you. Any questions from the legislators?

Legislator Drucker.

LEGISLATOR DRUCKER: Thank you,
Madam Chair. I have a question on
supplemental number 19.

How do the local water providers get

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access to any part of those funds which are used to evaluate emerging or volatile contaminants?

MS. ZOHRABIAN: This is for the second one for the Drinking Water Enhancement Grant?

LEGISLATOR DRUCKER: Supplemental number 19, for \$145,955.

MS. ZOHRABIAN: Yeah. So that program assures that the 46 water districts in Nassau County adhere and comply to part five of the New York State Sanitary Code and the Nassau County Public Health Ordinance. So that's use by our Division of Environmental Health.

LEGISLATOR DRUCKER: Right. But how did they get the money to help them in their evaluation? Every water provider has wells in their own community, in their own district, their own whatever. And they want to be able to evaluate their own in that community.

MS. DESIMONE: Ann DeSimone, Health. So they can check their own water supply.

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But this grant does the double check and has our staff go out and actually sample the water. And that this money takes care of, that pays for the sampling.

LEGISLATOR DRUCKER: Well, who asks the County to go out and double check?

MS. DESIMONE: It's a public health

LEGISLATOR DRUCKER: So you have to go out to all of the providers?

MS. DESIMONE: Correct.

law.

LEGISLATOR DRUCKER: So this money obviously is not a lot, but it's enough to help with the existing funding that you have to do this outreach.

MS. DESIMONE: It pays for the staff and the the specimen how they do the bacteriological sampling at the lab.

LEGISLATOR DRUCKER: Thank you. That's really what I wanted to know. Appreciate it.

CHAIRWOMAN WALKER: Can I just ask too, we know that the water districts do all their own testing, and I know the

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water districts that Arnie and I represent, they do plenty of testing because they have a lot of issues. But do you find that your testing matches their testing, or have you found that there are often times where you find something they don't?

MS. DESIMONE: We're going to have to get back to you on that. That's too much program detail for us to answer you.

CHAIRWOMAN WALKER: Okay. I mean, I would assume. I mean, the water districts are very, very attuned to what they have to do. So I would hope that answer is you find them to be doing the right thing. But just I'd like to know that.

MS. DESIMONE: That's a good question.

CHAIRWOMAN WALKER: Mazi.

LEGISLATOR PILIP: Thank you. I would like to know, are you checking all the water districts? How often?

MS. ZOHRABIAN: I don't know how exactly how often we can ask program and
