I've got three supplemental appropriations before you today. None of them have a cost match. They are all basically free money for the County.

The first one is a grant from New York State to support interoperable communications. It's basically funded by a 911 surcharge on your cell phone bill. It's for \$887,854. Currently, we've been utilizing this to purchase subscriber equipment for the new PD 700MHz system.

The second item is the Public Safety

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Answering Point grant. It is also a New York state funded grant. It's in the amount of \$126,372. We've been using that to purchase new furniture, ergonomic furniture for the 911 center for their operators so they better working conditions.

And the last one. We were awarded \$2.06 million under the Safer Grant that we applied for last spring. I'm personally really proud to get this award. They're really hard to get.

This is a federally FEMA funded grant that affords us to run the tuition reimbursement program at Nassau Community College, along with other marketing to promote firefighter recruitment and retention.
