There is one item on the agenda today, Clerk Item 22-24. It's an ordinance supplemental to the annual appropriation ordinance in connection with the Health Department.

May I have a motion, please?

Motioned by Legislator Ferretti and seconded by Legislator Koslow.

MS. ZOHRABIAN: Good afternoon, Alyssa Zohrabian, Nassau County Department of Health.

Item 22-24 includes three supplemental appropriations. The first is in the amount of \$25,349 for a performance incentive award from the New York State Department of Health. It was an award given for a wastewater monitoring project that the Health

/

Department did last year. The grant is being used for personal services, equipment and supplies needed to conduct Health Department activities.

MS. DOOLING: Hi. Good afternoon,
Karen Dooling, Assistant director, Crime
lab.

The second grant you have is for \$57,433. This is a federal pass-through. It's the 2023 Paul Coverdell Forensic Sciences Improvement grant. This grant is used for overtime for the opioid crisis to reduce backlogs. And it's also used for our laboratory information management system at the Crime Lab.

The additional grant you have before you is for \$438,364. This is a federal grant. The funding year '23 Forensic DNA Backlog Reduction Program. This is specifically used for the DNA laboratory to reduce DNA backlogs for equipment, supplies over time and quality assurance instrument contracts.

Thank you.

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2 CHAIRWOMAN WALKER: Any questions 3 from the legislators?

Legislator Drucker.

LEGISLATOR DRUCKER: Thank you, Madam Chair.

The appropriation for the DNA backlog, 438,000, will that make a significant dent in the backlog?

MS. DOOLING: It's used for a number of things. It's used for a technology to help process samples faster.

But, yes, those monies do help us significantly work towards reducing backlog.

LEGISLATOR DRUCKER: Can you describe what your backlog is now?s101.

MS. DOOLING: So our biggest backlog right now is not processing the actual cases, it's in reviews. So the overtime on that particular grant is used for backlog case reviews. So the goal for the federal initiative is 30 day turnaround time.

LEGISLATOR DRUCKER: So will this

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money be also used for staffing to increase staffing?

MS. DOOLING: This grant cannot be used for staffing but it is used for overtime okay.

LEGISLATOR DRUCKER: Thank you.

CHAIRWOMAN WALKER: Do we hope to get rid of that backlog from this grant, or we still have a long way to go?

MS. DOOLING: We always hope to get that turnaround time to that 30 day mark. That ebbs and flows depending on initiatives, crime stats and many other things. But yes, we do hope to get that backlog down. And this is a grant we get from year to year; a two year award.

CHAIRWOMAN WALKER: Okay. So it's a big step towards doing that.

MS. DOOLING: Yes. Thank you.

CHAIRWOMAN WALKER: Any other
