CHAIRMAN MCKEVITT: We will now call
the Finance Committee to order. If the
Clerk, please call the roll.

CLERK PULITZER: Thank you,
Chairman.

Legislator Seth Koslow?

LEGISLATOR KOSLOW: Present.

CLERK PULITZER: Legislator Scott
Davis?

LEGISLATOR DAVIS: Present.

CLERK PULITZER: Ranking Member
Carrie A. Solages?

LEGISLATOR SOLAGES: Present.

CLERK PULITZER: Legislator Rose
Marie Walker?

LEGISLATOR WALKER: Here.

CLERK PULITZER: Legislator James
Kennedy?

LEGISLATOR KENNEDY: Here.

CLERK PULITZER: Vice Chairman John
Ferretti.

LEGISLATOR FERRETTI: Here.

Chairman Thomas McKevitt?

CHAIRMAN MCKEVITT: Here.

CLERK PULITZER: We have a quorum.

CHAIRMAN MCKEVITT: We just had one item which had been on another committee's agenda, which has been discussed, which is 69-24 is moved by Legislator Davis, second by Legislator Walker.

All in favor please say, "Aye".

(Whereupon, all members of the Finance Committee respond in favor with, "Aye".)

CHAIRMAN MCKEVITT: All against?

(Whereupon, no verbal response.)

CHAIRMAN MCKEVITT: Motion is passed.

We now have several items which are all budget transfers from a Management and Budget. They are items 70, 71, 73, 76, 77 and 78.

Moved by Legislator Koslow, second by Legislator Ferretti.

From the Administration.

MS. DESIMONE: Ann DeSimone, Health. Starting with 70, right?

CHAIRMAN MCKEVITT: Yes.

MS. DESIMONE: Item 70-24 is a board transfer in the amount of \$7,500 for the Early Intervention Grant. Savings and pension will be utilized to cover travel. Funds are 100% reimbursable by New York State Department of Health.

CHAIRMAN MCKEVITT: Any questions from the legislators?

(Whereupon, no verbal response.)

Next item 73.

MR. PERSICH: Good afternoon. Andy Persich, Management and Budget.

Item 73-24 is a supplemental appropriation for Legal Aid. It's a \$200,000 supplemental for caseload reductions as part of the ILS legislation in New York State.

CHAIRMAN MCKEVITT: Any discussion from the legislators.

(Whereupon, no verbal response.)

CHAIRMAN MCKEVITT: Item 76.

2 MR. PERSICH: This is a board
3 transfer between the Department of Human
4 Services for \$30,000 for Behavioral
5 Health Services. It's in the amount of
6 \$30,000, move money from General Expenses
7 to Equipment.

8 CHAIRMAN MCKEVITT: Any discussion?

9 (Whereupon, no verbal
10 response.)

11 CHAIRMAN MCKEVITT: If not, Item 77.

12 MR. PERSICH: Item 77 is a board
13 transfer for opioid funds. We're moving
14 it from Contractual Services into
15 Contractual Services, but for different
16 use, which will be for wastewater
17 monitoring. And the \$900,000 is to
18 purchase equipment in the Medical
19 Examiner's Office.

20 CHAIRMAN MCKEVITT: Any discussion
21 by the legislators?

22 (Whereupon, no verbal
23 response.)

24 CHAIRMAN MCKEVITT: If not, Item 78.

25 MR. PERSICH: Item 78 is the year

1
2 end board transfer, which is part of the
3 closing out of the books of the County.
4 It was done as an NOS, because we
5 erroneously missed a transfer for the
6 Legislative Majority, which that's why it
7 had to be a nature of substitution.

8 The County finished with a surplus
9 of approximately \$220 million, and we're
10 moving money into Suits and Damages,
11 Longevity. We're also funding the Tax
12 Cert Litigation fund. In addition, we're
13 putting 35 million into the bond
14 indebtedness, \$20 million into employee
15 benefits as a result of the new contracts
16 and the single payouts that will go along
17 with the new contracts, and we're putting
18 money into a labor reserve and into a
19 health insurance reserve. What we do is
20 we take all these surplus funds, and we
21 move it into these reserves to give the
22 county much more strong financial
23 stability going forward with the
24 uncertainty of what the economy is going
25 to look like.

2 CHAIRMAN MCKEVITT: Even though it's
3 a very large number from an ordinary
4 transfer, we do this every single year,
5 such as rolling over the money from one
6 year into the next year.

7 MR. PERSICH: That's basically what
8 we're doing. We're taking this surplus
9 and putting it into dedicated reserves so
10 that we're spending it on specific
11 purposes, which conforms to the guidance
12 that is done by the New York State
13 Comptroller's Office.

14 CHAIRMAN MCKEVITT: All right. Any
15 discussion on that item?

16 (Whereupon, no verbal
17 response.)

18 CHAIRMAN MCKEVITT: I realize
19 there's one item which I neglected to
20 mention because I originally thought
21 another committee, which is item number
22 71, which is also a budget transfer.

23 MR. PERSICH: I will handle that.
24 Sure. It's with the Police Department,
25 and it's for a \$20,345 to move money from

2 general expenses into Purchase Equipment
3 in the Police Department as a result of
4 grant funding.

5 CHAIRMAN MCKEVITT: Any discussion
6 by the legislators?

7 (Whereupon, no verbal
8 response.)

9 CHAIRMAN MCKEVITT: If not, thank
10 you very much.

11 MR. PERSICH: Thank you.

3 CHAIRMAN MCKEVITT: We have another
4 item which is 72-24, which is a
5 resolution to authorize execution of a
6 tax agreement between the County of
7 Nassau and East Meadow Knolls Development
8 Corporation IX.

9 So moved by Legislator Solages, and
10 second by Legislator Ferretti.

11 MR. HOMMEL: Good afternoon. Ted
12 Hommel with the County Attorney's Office,
13 appearing for the County Executive's
14 Office. This item is to approve a tax
15 exemption extension agreement for the
16 senior affordable cooperative apartment
17 development known as the East Meadow
18 Knolls IX. This extension is in
19 accordance with the Private Housing
20 Finance Law of New York, and it provides
21 for an extension of up to 25 years at a
22 prescribed rate of exemption. We have
23 representatives here from the Assessor's
24 Office. If there are any questions about
25 the rate of exemption over the 25 year

extended term, as well as counsel for the
East Meadow Knolls.

CHAIRMAN MCKEVITT: Any questions
from the legislators?

(Whereupon, no verbal
response.)

CHAIRMAN MCKEVITT: Thank you very
much.

2 CHAIRMAN MCKEVITT: We now have
3 three items which will be settlement of
4 litigation with Nassau County is number
5 74, which is Old House Lane, number 75,
6 which is Felice Quao, and 79, which is
7 Lagona.

8 We have a motion by Legislator
9 Koslow and second by Legislator Ferretti.

10 Because these are ordinarily done in
11 Executive Session. Motion for Executive
12 Session by Legislator Davis, second by
13 Legislator Kennedy.

14 All in favor by going to Executive
15 Session, all by saying, "Aye".

16 (Whereupon, all members of
17 the Finance Committee respond
18 in favor with, "Aye".)

19 CHAIRMAN MCKEVITT: All against?

20 (Whereupon, no verbal
21 response.)

22 CHAIRMAN MCKEVITT: Those are passed
23 unanimously; 7 to 0.

24 So now we'll convene into the
25 conference room on Executive Session,

2 both the Rules Committee and the Finance
3 Committee is invited on these matters in
4 Executive Session.

8 CHAIRMAN MCKEVITT: We go back to
9 now, items number 70, 71, 72, 73, 74, 75,
10 76, 77, 78 and 79, is there any public
11 comment?

13 response.)

14 CHAIRMAN MCKEVITT: If not, all in
15 favor, please, by saying, "Aye".

16 (Whereupon, all members of
17 the Finance Committee respond
18 in favor with, "Aye".)

19 CHAIRMAN MCKEVITT: All against?

20 (Whereupon, no verbal
21 response.)

22 CHAIRMAN MCKEVITT: Ayes have it.
23 Passed unanimously; 7 to 0.

24 Motion to adjourn.
