Narrative

Purpose: To authorize and award a purchase order for a Robotic Titrosampler & Accessories for the Nassau County Health Department.

Discussion: The Department of Shared Services, Office of Purchasing has determined that this is a sole source procurement. The Nassau County Health Department identified Brinkmann Instruments, Inc., dba Metrohm USA Inc., as the sole manufacturer of this product. Nassau County Department of Health laboratory, is requesting to replace an out of life titrosampler. This tests conductivity, PH value, alkalinity, and chloride in tap water and possible contamination. This fully automated system allows the determination of several parameters according to various standards within one analysis. The system also transfers the required volume of sample into an external titration vessel, further reducing manual sample preparation. All sensors can be calibrated automatically and the titer of each titrant can also be determined. This high degree of automation minimizes errors and guarantees outstanding reproducibility.

Impact on Funding: The maximum amount authorized under this purchase order shall be One Hundred Fourteen Thousand Five Hundred Seventy Dollars (\$114,570.00) from Capital funds (PWCAPCAP, 00006, 90640).

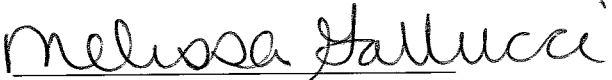

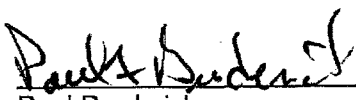
