Summary

This position will direct, administer, and provide guidance on the technologies for the MTA BSC Human Capital Management and Finance development. The Application Developer will also direct and manage, production and application support for these areas as well as the Portal for the Business Service Center (BSC). In addition, the Application Developer will also recommend and implement sound technical solutions that will improve the overall BSC PeopleSoft experience in these applications as well as the Internet, Intranet and Extranet Portal user experience. This position will actively participate in his/her area(s) of responsibility during the upgrade of the ERP software installation.

Responsibilities

This is a performance based position. Performance objectives and indicators have been designed to measure the successful candidate's achievements on a quarterly basis. The employee must meet or exceed these detailed goals as a condition of employment.

Other Responsibilities include:

Provide guidance and understanding of web technology, PeopleSoft applications, industry standards, and best practices to manage the BSC PeopleSoft environment and continuously improve the user experience based on business requirements.

Perform design, development, and modification activities to Batch processes, SQL objects, Peoplecode, and SQR to improve production processes.

Debug production functions and processes.

Analyze and troubleshoot production related issues.

Perform necessary configurations to implement or enhance existing modules.

Provide guidance and assistance to other team members.

Develop, testing, break/fix, workaround, ongoing enhancements and maintenance of PeopleSoft.

Implement and integrate technology components to meet clients' needs, deliver optimized User web experience.

Perform special projects as assigned.

Qualifications

Must have working experience with the some of the various components of the PeopleSoft technical architecture: Application Messaging, Integration Broker, App and Web Servers, Oracle PL/SQL (specifically Oracle functions and complex SQL)

Requires knowledge and experience in designing and developing interfaces using PeopleSoft Integration technologies

PeopleSoft version 9.0 (minimum) experience or above

Possess understanding and a working knowledge of core HR, Financial, EPM and ELM applications within at least two of the following PeopleSoft modules: Financials/Supply Chain Management, Procure to Pay, EProcurement, AP/GL, Portal, Inventory, HCM, or HCM to financials integration.

Ability to work successfully in a team environment and possess the flexibility/adaptability to changing requirements

Minimum four (4) years of work experience with PeopleSoft writing queries and understanding PeopleSoft security roles and implementation

Minimum of one (1) year experience acting as the lead technical person working with a group of IT professionals

Bachelor's Degree in Computer Science and other Technology field is strongly preferred
