



# SIGN UP FOR “SMART911”



Nassau County Executive Ed Mangelo launched a new “Smart911” public safety service to enhance 911 call taking, streamline response times, assist in planning and response in the event of a disaster, and provide emergency alerts to residents.

“Smart911” allows residents to create a free safety profile for their household at [www.Smart911.com](http://www.Smart911.com) that can include information necessary for 911 call takers to have in

the event of an emergency. Details can include the names and photos of all family members, medical conditions, allergies, pets, and emergency contacts.


This safety profile provides a way for residents to also include information that will enhance disaster response such as power needs for medical equipment, evacuation assistance and

sheltering needs. In the event of a natural disaster, public safety officials will be able to quickly determine which residents need assistance.

“Smart911” provides the capability to conduct Mass Emergency Alerting, allowing residents to opt-in to receive emergency alerts from public safety officials based on geographic locations of events. These mass notifications can be sent through various means including phone, text and e-mail.
