<u>Activity:</u> CDBG-DR funds will be used for a two phased project. The first phase will include an evaluation of existing facilities to assess their capabilities and conformance with stormwater best management practices. The analysis would include an examination of existing road section grades, cross sections and right-of-way limits to assess the suitability of green infrastructure. This will be followed by a second phase which will be implemented based on the analysis and prioritized list of improvements developed in Phase I.

<u>Objective:</u> To address the urgent need to provide drainage infrastructure upgrades to address widespread flooding resulting from Hurricane Sandy.

Location: The target area is Park Street, from Albany Avenue to Yates Avenue, in the Village of Atlantic Beach, and along Beech Street (Nassau County Route 22), from Yates Avenue to Nevada Street, in the hamlet of East Atlantic Beach (up to the border of the City of Long Beach). Park Street/Beech Street are the primary transportation corridor which links the barrier island from the Atlantic Beach Bridge through the City of Long Beach and they also serve as a coastal evacuation route.

<u>Amount:</u> Table 1 shows the CDBG-DR activity and the corresponding dollar amount for the East Atlantic Beach- Beech Street Drainage Improvements along with an estimate of the total project cost.
