Re: FY 16 Sales Tax and Year-End Growth Forecast

With the receipt of the January 12, 2017 sales tax check, the County has received all collections attributable to taxable sales made through November 30, 2016. Year-to-date sales tax collections total \$1,077.2 million. This is an increase of \$24.3 million, or 2.3%, over the receipts through the same period last year. The chart below details the year-to-date gross sales tax payments through January 12, 2017 compared to the same period last year.

The FY 16 sales tax budget, excluding the deferred piece, is \$1,117.7 million. Even with a negative growth of -20.4% in the remaining checks, the County would achieve the Adopted FY 16 sales tax budget.
