ORDERED, that within ninety (90) days of the making of this Order, an affidavit of publication as herein directed shall be filed in the Office of the Clerk of the County of Nassau; and it is further

ORDERED, that a copy of this Order be served on the Nassau County Board of Elections by either regular mail or personal service, proof of such service being an affidavit of mailing, or a stamped copy of the signed order indicating receipt and the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, Bureau of Citizenship and Immigration Services, such service to be made by certified mail, return receipt requested, or by mail deposited with a recognized private carrier, proof of such service being an affidavit of service and the receipt of payment for either the certified mail or the recognized private carrier (filing of the return receipt card not required), within sixty (60) days after the making of this Order, and proof of such service shall be filed with the Clerk of the Court no later than ninety days of the making of this Order; and it is further

ORDERED, that upon full compliance with the above provisions of this Order, the Petitioner (infant) shall be known by the name \_\_\_\_\_ which the Petitioner (infant) is hereby authorized to assume and by no other name.
