# PROPOSED PLAN OF ATTACK

- HEAVIER CONCENTRATION ON MAJOR SUPPLIERS OF HEROIN
- EMPLOYMENT OF ALL FORMS OF INVESTIGATIVE TOOLS, INCLUDING:
  - CONFIDENTIAL INFORMANTS
  - UNDERCOVER POLICE
  - EXPANDED USE OF ELECTRONIC SURVEILLANCE

# BENEFITS OF ELECTRONIC SURVEILLANCE

- Wiretaps enable investigators to identify and procure evidence against virtually every member of a narcotics conspiracy.
- The evidence obtained enables law enforcement to locate both drug mills and stash houses, as well as locations where profits from illegal activities are safeguarded
- Conversations enhance and compliment surveillance and help establish the significance of meetings and the relationships between suspects.
- Irrefutable evidence of guilt is established by the

# EXPANDED USE OF ELECTRONIC SURVEILLANCE

- Prior to the election of Madeline Singas, the NCDA did at most two narcotics investigations a year involving wiretaps.
- During 2016, the NCDA initiated FOUR separate narcotics wiretap investigations, writing and execution orders for over 25 separate telephones.

# BRIAN JONES INVESTIGATION

- Case started with a traffic stop. This defendant became a CI.
- CI made phone calls and ordered and purchased twice from Brian Jones.
- Electronic eavesdropping orders executed on two telephones of Brian Jones
- Investigators identified and arrested both customers of and supplier to Brian Jones.
- 9 people arrested in total.

# TOTAL OF NARCOTICS RECOVERED

- Over 3,250 glassines of heroin
- 3 kilograms of cocaine
- 20 kilograms of cutting agent



# OPERATION GRAM SLAM

- 32 people indicted
- 7 people charged as major traffickers
- 19 have plead guilty – 2 of whom are sentenced to 10 years in prison
- 2 have been abated by death
- 1 dismissed, one unapprehended
- 9 are pending trial

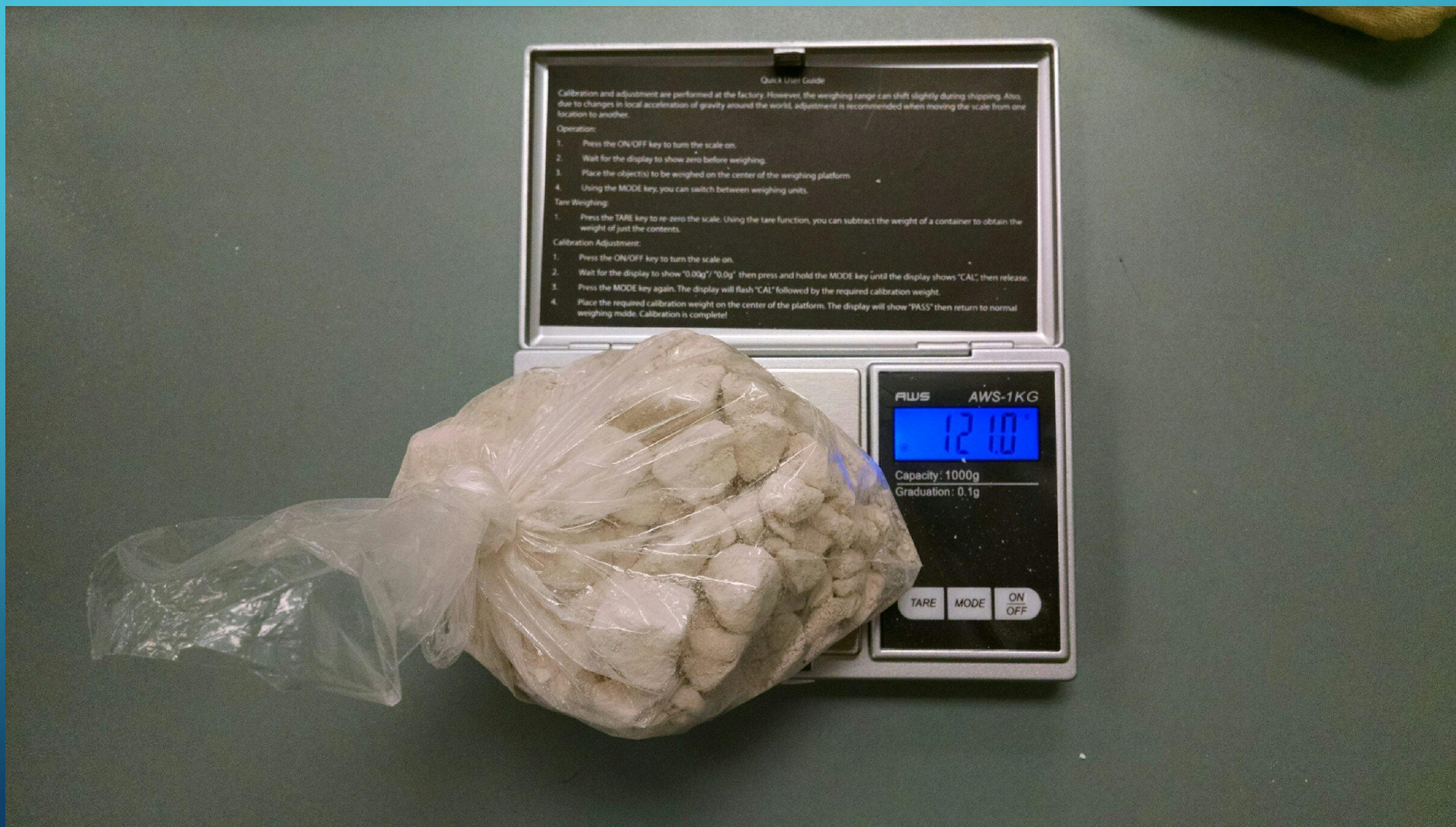

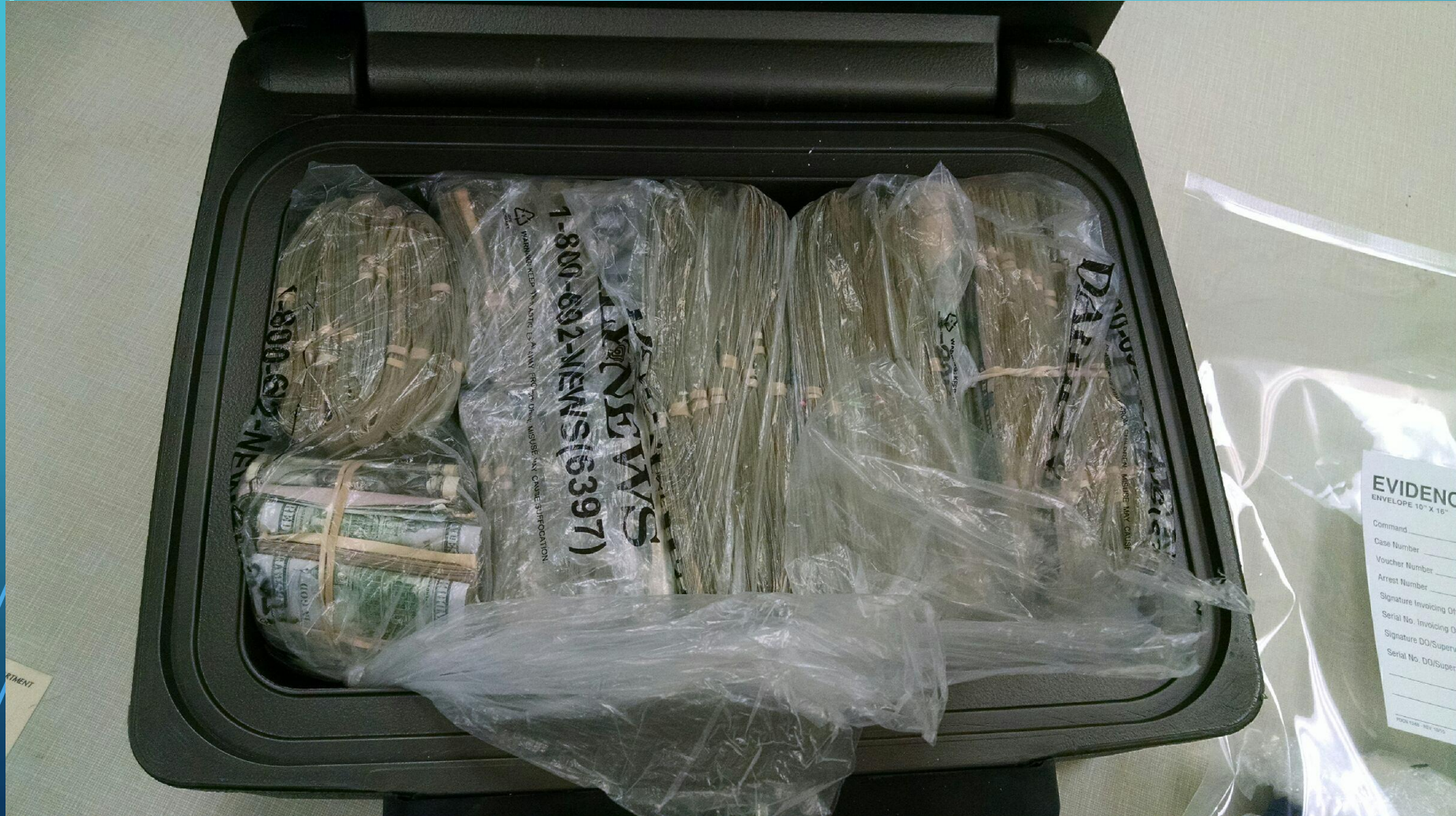
