GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES

Follows the nursing care plan for individualized patient care at an Opioid Treatment Program; as a member of the nursing staff, performs all required functions in diagnosing and treating human responses to health problems; performs related duties as required with a focus on safe and effective administration of medication.

TYPICAL DUTIES

- Applies nursing principles and techniques in the care and treatment of Opioid Treatment Program clients.
- Administer medications and treatments as prescribed by the physician, performs related nursing functions.
- Assumes responsibility for pertinent recordings of observations, medications, treatments, patient reactions and activities.
- Assists non-professional employees in Opioid Treatment Program routines and practices.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

Graduate of an accredited school of nursing. Possession of a current license to practice as a registered professional nurse in New York State.

RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS

Must have resided in Nassau County for one year prior to date of hire.
