GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES

Supervises extermination and control of mosquitos is an assigned area; performs related duties as required

TYPICAL DUTIES

- 1. Inspects possible mosquito breeding sites in assigned area at regular intervals.
- 2. Supervises the application of appropriate extermination and control procedures.
- 3. Inspects private premises upon request and advises homeowners as to proper methods of extermination and control.
- 4. Supervises removal of obstructions in streams, ditches and culverts.
- 5. Prepares records of work completed and labor utilized.
- 6. Maintains breeding site records and maps.
