The recently approved Nassau County Fire Prevention Ordinance, Article XXIV, sets forth the minimum requirements for design drawings for the following systems:

Flammable & Combustible Liquids
Application of Flammable Finishes
Liquefied Petroleum Gas (Propane)
Fire Alarm System
Fire Sprinkler System
Standpipe and Hose System
Grease Hood and Duct System
Automatic Fire Extinguishing System
Alternative Automatic Fire Extinguishing System (Clean Agent Fire System)
Pyrotechnics
Special Systems

Included in these requirements is the adoption of NFPA 170, Standard for Fire Safety & Emergency Symbols.

In an effort to standardize design drawings submitted to the Nassau County Fire Marshal, all design drawings shall utilize the appropriate symbols specified in **NFPA 170-2015**, effective **May 1, 2017**.

Any design drawings submitted on or after **May 1, 2017** that do not conform to the symbols in NFPA 170-2015 will be rejected.
