Abraham H. Foxman

Born in 1940, Abraham H. Foxman, was saved from the Holocaust by his Polish Catholic nursemaid raising him as a Catholic. Although 14 members of his family perished, his mother and father survived and the three came to American in 1950. He served at the Anti-Defamation League for 50 years, retiring as Executive Director. Mr. Foxman is at the forefront of major issues today including global anti-Semitism, the war on terrorism, and all forms of discrimination, hatred and violence wherever they occur.
