

## **REOPENING GUIDELINES FOR LIBRARIES**

Libraries that are operated by a local government or political subdivision are allowed to operate, as business restrictions do not apply to government agencies or entities. As a unit of local government, they are, however, subject to the 50% reduction in non-essential workforce that remains in effect and may consider alternate modes of operation (e.g. curbside or "in store" pickup) as they so determine. Libraries that are operated by a not-for-profit or other non-governmental organization may perform curbside or "in-store" pickup once the region in which they are located reaches Phase 1 and may perform other "in-store" operations once the region in which they are located reaches Phase 2.
