## REOPENING GUIDELINES FOR LIBRARIES

**Libraries that are operated by a local government or political subdivision are allowed to operate, as business restrictions do not apply to government agencies or entities.** As a unit of local government, they are, however, subject to the 50% reduction in non-essential workforce that remains in effect and may consider alternate modes of operation (e.g. curbside or “in store” pickup) as they so determine. **Libraries that are operated by a not-for-profit or other non-governmental organization may perform curbside or “in-store” pickup once the region in which they are located reaches Phase 1 and may perform other “in-store” operations once the region in which they are located reaches Phase 2.**

In order to operate, you must comply with all safety guidelines for your industry, as well as any additional health and safety guidance issued by the state.
