

Notice to Public of Nassau Urban County Consortium's Substantial
Amendment to the FY2019 Annual Action Plan and Five-Year Consolidated Plan's
(2015-2019) Citizen Participation Plan

The County of Nassau hereby gives notice that the County's FY2019 Annual Action Plan which was prepared pursuant to Title I of the National Affordable Housing Act has been substantially amended to address the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act - 2020. The development of the Annual Action Plan was undertaken by the Nassau County Office of Community Development in coordination with the 30 communities in the Nassau Urban County Consortium, various Nassau County agencies and departments and other housing providers and social services agencies in Nassau. In conjunction, the Nassau County Five-Year Consolidated Plan (FY2015-2019) Citizen Participation Plan has been revised.

The CARES Act was put forth by Congress to protect the American people from the public health and economic impacts of COVID-19. CARES Act Funding has been awarded to Nassau County from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to be used to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the coronavirus pandemic (COVID-19). Funds in the amount of \$9,564,934 has been allocated to the Community Development Block Grant Coronavirus (CDBG-CV) and \$10,647,918 to the Emergency Solutions Grants Coronavirus (ESG-CV) programs. Priority will be given to programs and organizations that successfully align with strategies to address the needs of low-to-moderate income individuals and Nassau County businesses with respect to COVID-19.

PUBLIC COMMENT
